Seattle to Portland bike route includes U.S. 30 this weekend

Estimated 10,000 bicyclists expected to travel on U.S. 30 from Rainier to Portland

Motorists and bicyclists are asked to travel with caution along U.S. 30 (Lower Columbia River Highway) between Rainier and Portland this weekend.

Approximately 10,000 bicyclists plan to take part in the Cascade Bicycle Club's 2010 Seattle to Portland ride this year. About 30% are expected to cross the Lewis & Clark Bridge at Rainier on Saturday, July 17, and travel to Portland via U.S. 30; the remaining riders will cross the bridge on their way to Portland on Sunday, July 18. Riders will exit U.S. 30 at N.W. St. Helens Road in Portland and proceed along city streets to access the Steel Bridge and continue to the finish line at Holladay Park.
