OVERNIGHT RAMP CLOSURES ON U.S. 26

The contractor on the U.S. 26 - Cornell Road to Highway 217 project will temporarily close two off-ramps from eastbound U.S. 26 (Sunset Highway) this weekend. Dates, times and locations of the ramp closures are listed below.

Friday, Nov. 18:

The off-ramp from eastbound U.S. 26 to Murray Boulevard will close at 8 p.m. for drainage work. The off-ramp will remain closed until approximately 7 a.m. Saturday, Nov. 19. Motorists on U.S. 26 east that are bound for Murray Boulevard can take the Cornell Road off-ramp, head north on Cornell Road to Murray Boulevard or head south on 158th Avenue and then east on Walker Road to Murray Boulevard.

Saturday, Nov. 19:

The off-ramp from eastbound U.S. 26 to Cedar Hills Boulevard will close at 11 p.m. for ramp paving work. The off-ramp will remain closed until 5 a.m. Sunday, Nov. 20. During the ramp closure period motorists bound for Cedar Hills Boulevard from eastbound U.S. 26 should continue to southbound Highway 217, take the Walker Road off-ramp and proceed west on Walker Road to Cedar Hills Boulevard. This paving work is weather dependent.
