REGION 1 UPDATE: U.S. 26 REOPENED; HIGHWAY 6 REMAINS CLOSED

U.S. 26

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) has reopened U.S. 26 (Sunset Highway) to all motorists. U.S. 26 was closed after trees and other debris blocked the highway Thursday night and Friday morning between Staley's Junction (milepost 45) and milepost 15, three miles west of Alder Creek Road. Though U.S. 26 is open, flaggers will control both directions of traffic at milepost 36, about two miles west of Sunset Camp, where crews are clearing trees from the highway.

Highway 6 is closed between Banks (milepost 49) and Donaldson Creek (milepost 4) until further notice. Crews are clearing trees and other debris from the highway.
