### OR99W: Crowley Creek Culvert Replacement

Last Updated: October 22, 2014

#### **Project Location**

The project is 3 miles north of Rickreall on OR 99W (MP 54.4).

#### **Project Purpose and Need**

The existing OR99W Crowley Creek metal culvert is collapsing, resulting in poor drainage, upstream flooding, and settlement of the highway embankment.



This project will replace the failing culvert with a new stream crossing structure. The structure will either be a culvert or bridge to be determined during the 30% design phase in Spring 2015.

#### **Construction Overview**

This project will benefit the traveling public by replacing a failing culvert, thereby ensuring continued use of the highway for freight and public transportation. Traffic staging to construct the new structure will be determined in Spring 2015. Traffic staging alternatives to be evaluated include a single lane controlled with a temporary signal, partial roadway realignment and rapid bridge construction with a short duration road closure. Construction is expected to occur in Spring 2017.

#### **Cost Estimate**
