Project location


- This project is along a 5 mile stretch of I-5 that begins north of Millersburg at the South Jefferson Interchange (MP 233) and ends at the US20 (Santiam Highway) Interchange (MP 238.50).

Project purpose and need

- This project will develop and evaluate alternatives that address the deficiencies and improve accessibility, mobility and safety in the I-5 corridor through Millersburg and Albany in northern Linn County. The project will complete an Environmental Assessment consistent with federal NEPA guidelines.
