Crook County, Oregon



Crook County, the City of Prineville, and the Oregon Department of Transportation are teaming up to establish a long-term plan to reduce congestion, improve safety, and serve future traffic on OR 126 from the Crook County line to the Prineville “Y”.

The OR Highway 126 Corridor Facility Plan project began in December 2010 and will continue through December 2011.

Throughout the project there are opportunities to provide your input on key decisions that will shape the future of the corridor. Topics to be discussed at this workshop include the number of travel lanes and the type of intersection control that could be implemented over the next 20 or more years.
