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## OR 31/U.S. 395: Cattlepass and Crooked Creek Bridge Replacements

**Bundle 404**

### ***Project description and need***

- Replace two bridges between Paisley and Lakeview on OR 31 and U.S. 395.
- Workers will replace the two aging bridges to meet modern traffic standards.

### ***Overview of construction activity***

- Replace the bridge on Highway 31 located four miles east of Paisley at milepost 102.40.
- Replace bridge over Crooked Creek on U.S. 395 located 16 miles north of Lakeview at milepost 126.9.

### ***Construction impacts***

- Construction crews will maintain access to Highway 31 and U.S. 395 during construction, with local roadway or driveway approaches maintained at approximately their existing locations.
- The project team will coordinate timing of bridge work with local landowners to minimize impacts associated with cattle crossings.
- Project leaders will coordinate mobility impacts with the adjacent ODOT projects.
- Traffic on OR 31 at the Cattlepass Bridge will be down to a one lane detour controlled by 24-hour flagging.

### ***Key project milestones***

- Design approval – 11/7/07
- Bid let date - 07/24/2008
- Construction – Crooked Creek Bridge -2008 (paving 2009); Cattlepass Bridge -2009

### ***Project cost and funding***

- Construction cost - \$2.4 million funded by the Oregon Transportation Investment Act III
- Design Engineer - Hatch Mott MacDonald
- Construction Contractor- JAL Construction, Inc.
