



## **U.S. 20 @ Barclay Drive Open House Tuesday, April 14, 2015, 6-8 p.m.**



The Oregon Department of Transportation and the City of Sisters invite the public to an informational open house to learn about the proposed roundabout at the intersection of U.S. 20 and Barclay Drive. The open house will begin at 6 p.m. with a presentation at 6:15 p.m. A question and answer session will follow. The open house will be held at city hall, 520 East Cascade, Sisters, OR.

The proposal to construct a roundabout was first identified in the Sisters' Transportation System Plan, adopted by the City Council in 2010. In 2011, a feasibility study was conducted and at a November workshop community members determined that a roundabout was the preferred solution.

Since 2011, the City and ODOT have been working to secure funding for the project and to get concurrence on the roundabout design from the freight industry. Tests of the roundabout design were held in late February and early March of this year. The results of those tests will be shared at the open house.
