

US 395: South Fork Crane Creek Culvert

Project Location

This project is located on US 395 in Lake County approximately 5 miles south of Lakeview, OR (MP 148.7)

Project Description

US 395 is an important part of the State's transportation system and is an east-west freight corridor. Keeping the roads in good condition and providing a safe, efficient transportation system that supports economic opportunity is a critical aspect of the mission for the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT).



The existing double box culvert at this location is past its life expectancy and regularly fills with sediment and woody debris. ODOT plans to replace the culvert with a single span culvert with the correct horizontal and vertical alignment. This will improve access to the culvert and reduce maintenance costs by preventing debris clogs.

Traffic control during construction

During construction traffic will be restricted to one lane and controlled by flaggers and a pilot car. Motorists should plan for delays up to 20 minutes.
