Warm Springs Safety Plan

Location: US 26, Hwy. 9 to Gumwood Lane (MP 71.5 to MP 105.2)

Project Description: The Warm Springs Safety Plan will develop goals, objectives and strategies that supports the safety of US 26 through the Warm Springs Reservation. The plan will help fulfill safety planning efforts identified in the 2014 Warm Springs Transportation Plan, prioritizing safe and efficient infrastructure for all modes of transportation.

Timeline: Project kick off – May 2016
Project completion – August 2016

US 26: Kahneeta Jct. to Gumwood

Location: US 26, Kahneeta Jct. to Gumwood Lane (MP 103.3 to MP 105.2)

Project Description: This project is composed of several components:


- Design and construct pavement improvements to address roadway deterioration.
- Design and construct alternatives to reduce the risk of rock fall at MP 99.5.
- Design and construct a 10-foot wide multi-use path along US 26 between Warm Springs downtown commercial area to the Museum at Warm Springs. (not yet awarded)
- Coordinate with the Warm Springs Safety Plan to implement safety and traffic calming improvements between Kahneeta Jct. and the Museum.

Estimated Cost: \$7.5 million

Timeline: Project kick off – Spring 2016
Project construction – 2018 – 2021

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US 26 Rock Fall Project



Location: West of Kahneeta Jct. on US 26 (MP 99.5 to MP 102)

Project Description: Engineer and construct a cost effective solution to eliminate or significantly reduce the risk of rock fall on this section of highway.

Estimated Cost: \$1.5 million

Timeline: Project kick off – 2016
Project construction – Spring 2018

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
