BUILDING TRUST – AND A SAFETY PROJECT – ON MOUNT HOOD

Cutting back rock slopes, cutting down trees, and using explosives to blast slopes in one of the most beautiful places in Oregon concerned many community members on Mount Hood. In addition to the changes to the landscape, members of the community were concerned about closures of U.S. 26 required for the work.

After two dozen highway closures, convoys of haul trucks, and one of the biggest structural fires in Government Camp's recent history, ODOT is collaborating with K&E Excavating to address public concerns and build the trust of Mount Hood's community members.
