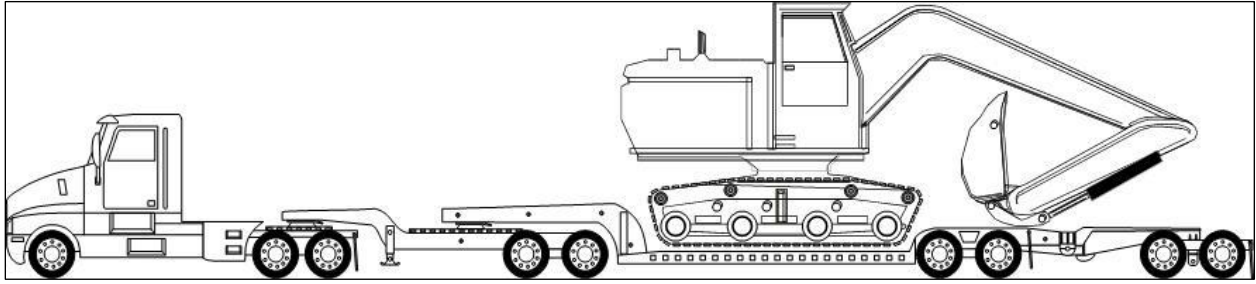


# Non-Divisible Loads



The following Holidays have restrictions for Non-divisible loads. See below for specific restrictions:

## **Memorial Day - Observed - Monday, May 28, 2018**

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Friday, May 25 until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Tuesday, May 29. Except, loads may travel at night beginning at 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, May 29, on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet\*.

### **Exceptions to holiday weekend travel restrictions for non-divisible loads:**

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet, movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset on Interstates, US97, and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) on Saturday (May 26) and Sunday (May 27).

Loads may also travel night from 12:01 a.m. Saturday (May 26) to 12 Midnight Sunday (May 27) at the following dimensions on the following routes\*:

- Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways
- Up to 10 feet in width - US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which is also shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#)

Note: No overwidth movement allowed at all after 12 Noon on Friday (May 25) or all day Monday (May 28).

## **Independence Day - Observed - Wednesday, July 4, 2018**

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Tuesday, July 3 until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Thursday, July 5. Except, loads may travel at night

beginning at 12:01 a.m. Thursday, July 5, on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet\*.

### **Labor Day - Observed - Monday, September 3, 2018**

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Friday, August 31, until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Tuesday, September 4. Except, loads may travel at night beginning at 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, September 4, on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet\*.

#### **Exceptions to holiday weekend travel restrictions for non-divisible loads:**

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet, movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset on Interstates, US97, and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) on Saturday (September 1) and Sunday (September 2).

Loads may also travel at night from 12:01 a.m. Saturday (September 1) to 12 Midnight Sunday (September 2) at the following dimensions on the following routes\*:

- Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways
- Up to 10 feet in width - US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which is also shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#)

Note: No overwidth movement allowed at all after 12 Noon on Friday (August 31) or all day Monday (September 3).

### **Thanksgiving - Observed Thursday and Friday, November 22-23, 2018**

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Wednesday, November 21 until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Monday, November 26. Except, loads may travel at night beginning at 12:01 a.m. Monday, November 26, on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet\*.

#### **Exceptions to holiday weekend travel restrictions for non-divisible loads:**

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet, movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset on Interstates, US97, and

any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) on Thursday (November 22), Friday (November 23), and Saturday (November 24).

Loads may also travel at night from 12:01 a.m. Thursday (November 22) to 12 Midnight Saturday (November 25) at the following dimensions on the following routes\*:

- Up to 12 feet in width on Interstate Highways
- Up to 10 feet in width - US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which is also shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#)

Note: No overwidth movement allowed at all after 12 Noon on Wednesday (November 21) or all day Sunday (November 25).

### **Christmas - Observed - Tuesday, December 25, 2018**

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Monday, December 24 until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Wednesday, December 26. Except, loads may travel at night beginning at 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, December 26 on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet\*.

### **New Year's Day 2019 - Observed - Tuesday, January 1, 2019**

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Monday, December 31 until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Wednesday, January 2. Except, loads may travel at night beginning at 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, January 2 on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet\*.

\*When operating during the hours of darkness, the outermost extremities must be illuminated by lamps or markers as described by the requirements of [ORS Chapter 816](#) and [FMCSR Chapter 393](#), in addition to all other lighting and warning sign requirements described in OAR Chapter 734, [Division 82](#).

The following state observed holidays are not travel restricted:

- **Martin Luther King, Jr. Day** – Observed Monday, January 15, 2018.
- **President's Day** – Observed Monday, February 19, 2018.
- **Veterans Day** – Observed Monday, November 12, 2018.
