

Non-Divisible Loads

The following Holidays have restrictions for Non-divisible loads. See below for specific restrictions:

Memorial Day - Observed - Monday, May 29, 2017

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Friday, May 26 until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Tuesday, May 30. Except, loads may travel at night beginning at 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, May 30, on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet*.

Exceptions to holiday weekend travel restrictions for non-divisible loads:

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet, movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset on Interstates, US97, and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) on Saturday (May 27) and Sunday (May 28).

Loads may also travel night from 12:01 a.m. Saturday (May 27) to 12 Midnight Sunday (May 28) at the following dimensions on the following routes*:

- Up to 12 feet in width - Interstate Highways; and
- Up to 10 feet in width - US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which is also shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#)

Note: No overwidth movement allowed at all after 12 Noon on Friday (May 26) or all day Monday (May 29).

Independence Day - Observed - Tuesday, July 4, 2017

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Monday, July 3 until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Wednesday, July 5. Except, loads may travel at night beginning at 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, July 5, on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet*.

Labor Day - Observed - Monday, September 4, 2017

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Friday, September 1, until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Tuesday, September 5. Except, loads may travel at night beginning at 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, September 5, on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet*.

Exceptions to holiday weekend travel restrictions for non-divisible loads:

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet, movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset on Interstates, US97, and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) on Saturday (September 2) and Sunday (September 3).

Loads may also travel at night from 12:01 a.m. Saturday (September 2) to 12 Midnight Sunday (September 3) at the following dimensions on the following routes*:

- Up to 12 feet in width - Interstate Highways; and
- Up to 10 feet in width - US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which is also shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#)

Note: No overwidth movement allowed at all after 12 Noon on Friday (September 1) or all day Monday (September 4).

Thanksgiving - Observed - Thursday, November 23, 2017

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Wednesday, November 22 until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Monday, November 27. Except, loads may travel at night beginning at 12:01 a.m. Monday, November 27, on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet*.

Exceptions to holiday weekend travel restrictions for non-divisible loads:

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet, movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset on Interstates, US97, and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) on Thursday (November 23), Friday (November 24), and Saturday (November 25).

Loads may also travel at night from 12:01 a.m. Thursday (November 23) to 12 Midnight Saturday (November 25) at the following dimensions on the following routes*:

- Up to 12 feet in width - Interstate Highways; and
- Up to 10 feet in width - US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which is also shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#)

Note: No overwidth movement allowed at all after 12 Noon on Wednesday (November 22) or all day Sunday (November 26).

Christmas - Observed - Monday, December 25, 2017

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Friday, December 22 until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Tuesday, December 26. Except, loads may travel at night beginning at 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, December 26 on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet*.

Exceptions to holiday weekend travel restrictions for non-divisible loads:

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet, movement is allowed from 1/2 hour before sunrise to 1/2 hour after sunset on Interstates, US97, and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) on Saturday (December 23) and Sunday (December 24).

Loads may also travel at night from 12:01 a.m. Saturday (December 23) to 12 Midnight Sunday (December 24) at the following dimensions on the following routes*:

- Up to 12 feet in width - Interstate Highways; and
- Up to 10 feet in width - US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which is also shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#).

Note: No overwidth movement allowed at all after 12 Noon on Friday (December 22) or all day Monday (December 25).

New Year's Day 2018 - Observed - Monday, January 1, 2018

No movement if over 8 feet 6 inches wide from Noon Friday, December 29 until 1/2 hour before Sunrise Tuesday, January 2. Except, loads may travel at night beginning at 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, January 2 on Interstate Highways when width does not exceed 12 feet, and on other highways which are shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#) when width does not exceed 10 feet*.

Exceptions to holiday weekend travel restrictions for non-divisible loads:

When the overall width does not exceed 14 feet, movement is allowed from ½ hour before sunrise to ½ hour after sunset on Interstates, US97, and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) on Saturday (December 30) and Sunday (December 31).

Loads may also travel at night from 12:01 a.m. Saturday (December 30) to 12 Midnight Sunday (December 31) at the following dimensions on the following routes*:

- Up to 12 feet in width - Interstate Highways; and
- Up to 10 feet in width - US97 and any route east of US97 shown in Black on [Route Map 9](#) AND which is also shown in Green on [Route Map 2](#).

Note: No overwidth movement allowed at all after 12 Noon on Friday (December 29) or all day Monday (January 1).

*When operating during the hours of darkness, the outermost extremities must be illuminated by lamps or markers as described by the requirements of [ORS Chapter 816](#) and [FMCSR Chapter 393](#), in addition to all other lighting and warning sign requirements described in [Division 82](#).
