SUBJECT: **I-405 NB RAMP CLOSURES IN THE PORTLAND AREA**

Beginning Friday, May 3, 2019, the following ramp closures will take place in the Portland area:

I-405 NB Exit 3 off-ramp to US30 WB

The I-405 northbound Exit 3 off-ramp to US30 westbound will be closed weekends starting Friday night at 9 PM at all hours until Monday morning at 10 AM.

I-405 NB off-ramp to I-5 SB

The I-405 northbound off-ramp to I-5 southbound will be closed weekends starting Friday night at 9 PM at all hours until Monday morning at 10 AM.

The ramp closures are necessary to install and remove temporary work access and containment, perform bridge removal and bridge deck repairs, for joint replacement, and to remove and replace pavement and concrete. The estimated date of completion of this work is May 13, 2019.

Detour Route Information:

When the I-405 northbound Exit 3 off-ramp to US30 westbound will be closed, motor carriers will be directed to continue on I-405 northbound (Fremont Bridge) to I-5 northbound, take exit 304 to Rosa Parks Way to I-5 southbound, take exit 3 to US30 westbound.

When the I-405 northbound off-ramp to I-5 southbound will be closed, motor carriers will be directed to go I-405 southbound to I-5 northbound (Marquam Bridge).

For questions or help with determining authorized alternate routes, please contact the Over-Dimension Permit Unit Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. at 503-373-0000.

Motor Carriers need to provide this information to their drivers, by copy of this letter or other means, to assure their awareness of the restriction.

Road Restriction/Dates May Change due to weather or other unforeseen delays.

To discontinue receiving paper copies by mail, you must sign up for GovDelivery to be notified of important size and weight restrictions electronically.
