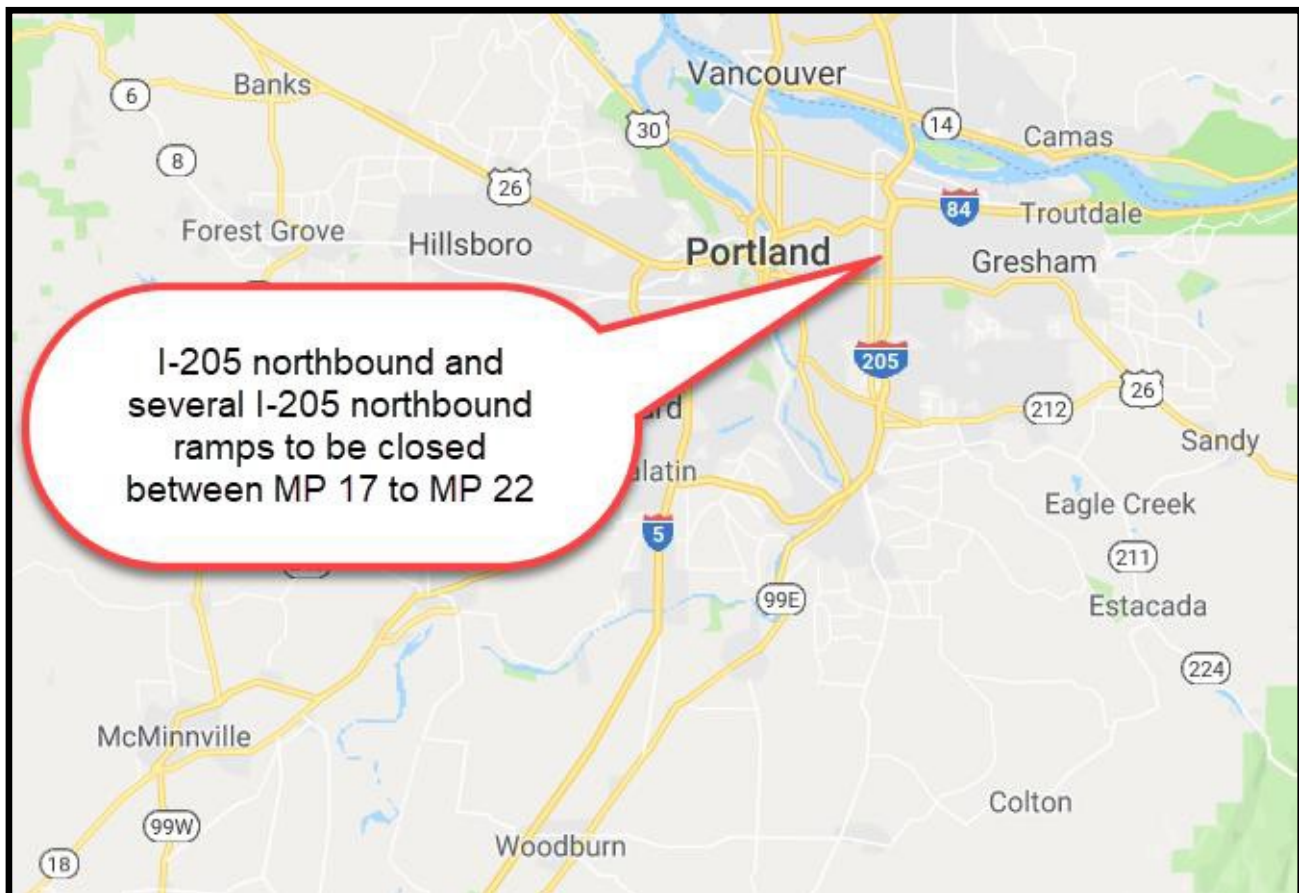

SUBJECT: **I-205 northbound and multiple ramp closures (Portland)**

A major paving project will require the following mainline and ramp closures in Portland this August. Beginning at 10 p.m. on Friday August 2, 2019, I-205 northbound between MP 17 to MP 22 and the following intermediate ramps will be closed at all hours.

- US26/Powell Blvd/Division Street Exit 19 off-ramp
- US26/Powell Blvd on-ramp
- Division Street on-ramp
- Washington Street Exit 20 off-ramp
- Glisan Street Exit 21A off-ramp

The estimated date of completion of this work is 5 a.m. on Monday, August 5, 2019.



Detour Route Information:

When I-205 northbound and I-205 northbound ramps are closed, motor carriers will need to avoid this area or use alternate authorized routes.

To discontinue receiving paper copies by mail, you must sign up for GovDelivery to be notified of important size and weight restrictions electronically.
