SUBJECT: **Consent 8** – Resolution to Amend the Oregon Highway Plan in accordance with Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement 839 and under the authority of Oregon Regulatory Statute (ORS) 374.329, and approve the resolution to transfer jurisdiction of the North Santiam River Bridge and the North Santiam Connector from the State of Oregon to Linn County and the City of Mill City and direct staff to transfer all property interests thereof.

Requested Action:

Approve the following actions for two resolutions to transfer jurisdiction:

- Approve resolution to transfer jurisdiction of the following segment of highway from the State of Oregon to Linn County: The North Santiam Connector section of the North Santiam Connector Highway (Oregon 22) in Linn County; all that portion of the active right of way on the North Santiam Connector lying northerly of the center line of the North Santiam River at the Linn County and Marion County line and southerly of the northerly most end of the North Santiam River Bridge No. 02058 structure; and the adjoining bridge property parcels identified as Units B, C, and D that are used to obtain maintenance access to the North Santiam River Bridge to Linn County, direct staff to transfer all rights, title and interest over segment, and approve minor amendment to the Oregon Highway Plan to eliminate this segment from the Oregon Highway Plan.
- Approve resolution to transfer jurisdiction of the following segment of highway from the State of Oregon to Mill City: All that portion of the active right of way of the North Santiam Connector Section of the North Santiam Connector Highway (Oregon 22) in Marion County lying northerly of the northerly most end of the North Santiam River Bridge No. 02058 structure and southerly of the north right of way of NE Wall Street (a Mill City street) to Mill City, direct staff to transfer all rights, title and interest over segment, and approve minor amendment to the Oregon Highway Plan to eliminate this segment from the Oregon Highway Plan.

Background:

By the authority granted in ORS 374.329, the state may enter into an agreement to transfer jurisdiction and ownership of a state highway segment to a county or city. The North Santiam River Bridge, North Santiam Connector, and adjoining Unit parcels B, C, and D are more appropriately characterized as county and/or city highway facilities and serve no state highway purpose.

The State of Oregon and Linn County have maintained a joint ownership and maintenance agreement for the North Santiam River Bridge since 1961, when the south portion of the bridge was transferred to Linn County in Resolution Number 58 and the north portion was retained by the State of Oregon. In 2017, the county and city of Mill City were jointly awarded a Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) grant to repair the North Santiam River Bridge and enhance pedestrian safety by improving sidewalk and crosswalk designs and curb ramps on the North Santiam Connector. The parties entered into Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement 839 in which the parties agreed to the terms and conditions for the jurisdiction, maintenance and control of these segments. Approving this resolution and actions will implement the terms of the Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement and will allow the county and city to independently manage the local highway and bridge and perform necessary repairs and improvements to their facilities through the TIGER grant, while allowing the State to focus its maintenance resources on its existing National Highway System highway facilities.

State of Oregon shall provide no funds to Linn County or Mill City for this transfer.

Options:

With approval, Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) will proceed to complete the jurisdictional transfer as outlined in Jurisdictional Transfer Agreement 839, amend the State Highway Plan to eliminate the northern portion of the North Santiam River Bridge and the North Santiam Connector, transfer jurisdiction and control of these segments to the respective local agencies and will take all actions necessary to transfer the underlying property interests of these segments to the respective local agencies.

Without approval, the jurisdictional transfer will not be completed and the State of Oregon will retain jurisdiction of the northern portion of the North Santiam River Bridge and the North Santiam Connector.

Interjurisdictional Transfers Amending the Oregon Highway Plan



Summary

This document summarizes interjurisdictional transfers approved by the Oregon Transportation Commission (OTC) or designee that amend the Oregon Highway Plan (1999), Appendix D: Highway Classification by Milepoint.

This table on the following pages lists the transfer number, county where the transfer occurred, agency receiving the facility, highway classification information, and the date the OTC or designee resolved to remove from or add to the state highway system.

Notes

1. Some jurisdictional transfer numbers are not shown. In the process of developing jurisdictional transfers, ODOT assigns a unique tracking number to each. Ultimately, some jurisdictional transfers are cancelled, merged with another jurisdictional transfer, or are completed long after other transfers in the numbering sequence.
2. The table on the following pages uses state highway numbers rather than more familiar route numbers (i.e., I-5, US 30, or OR 22). The reason is that not all facilities on the state highway system have route numbers, whereas all facilities have state highway numbers. For the corresponding route number, see the Oregon Highway Plan, Appendix D.
