Getting to OReGO: A timeline

- 1919** Oregon Legislature enacts nation's first gas tax.
- 1947** Oregon enacts weight-mile tax for commercial vehicles in excess of 26,000 pounds.
- 2001** Oregon Legislature forms Road User Fee Tax Force (RUFTF) to explore new ways of funding the state's transportation system.
- 2012** Oregon welcomes volunteers for the Road Usage Charge Pilot Program.
- 2013** Oregon passes legislation establishing the nation's first mileage-based (road usage) revenue program for light-duty vehicles.
- 2014** ODOT conducts a statewide listening tour to hear Oregonian's thoughts about OReGO.
- 2015** OReGO launches on July 1.
- 2016-2018** FAST Act grant work.
