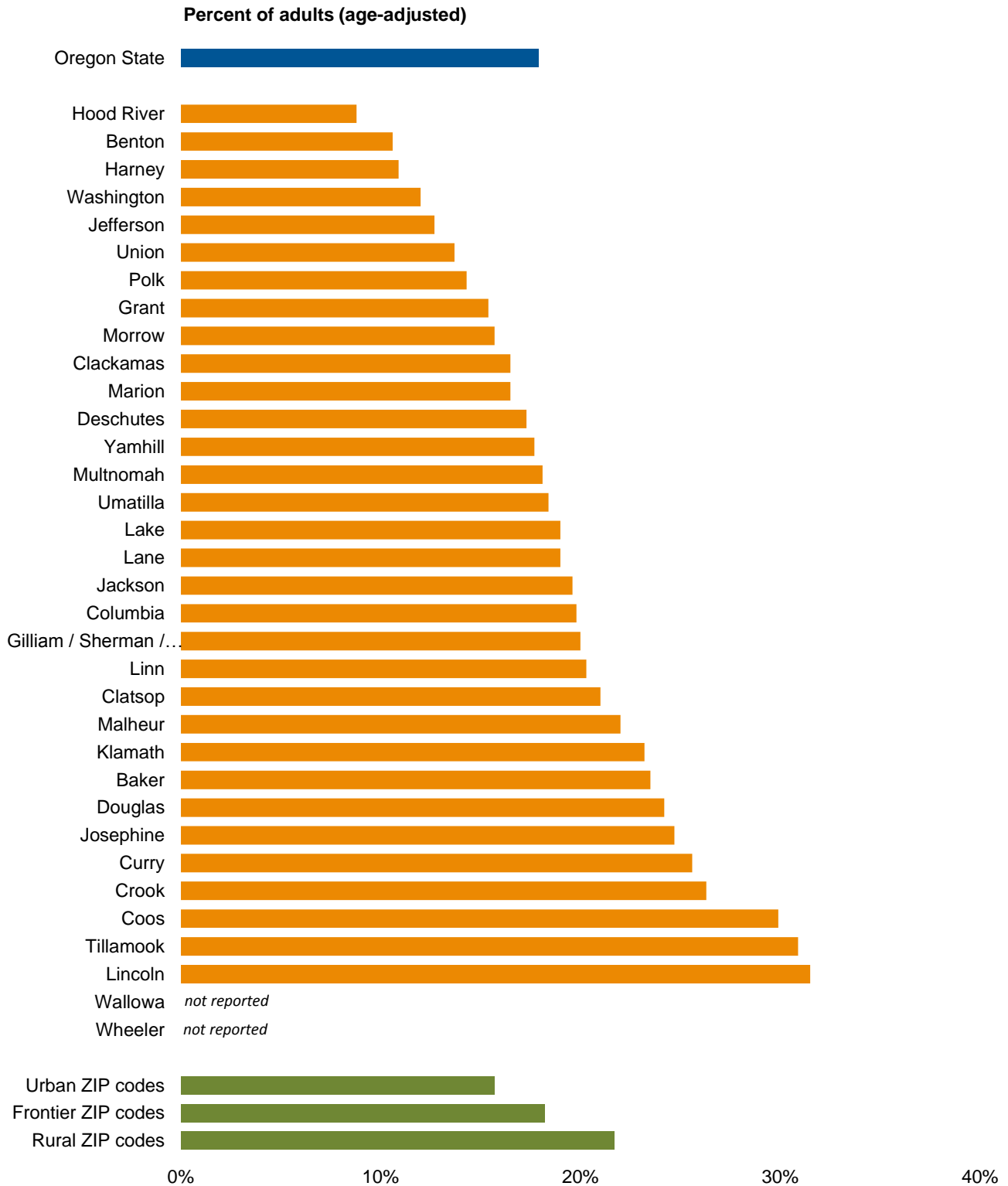

Age-Adjusted to standard U.S. 2000 population - 3 groups (18-34, 35-54, 55+)

Includes respondents who have smoked 100 cigarettes in their lifetime and currently smoke every day or some days.
