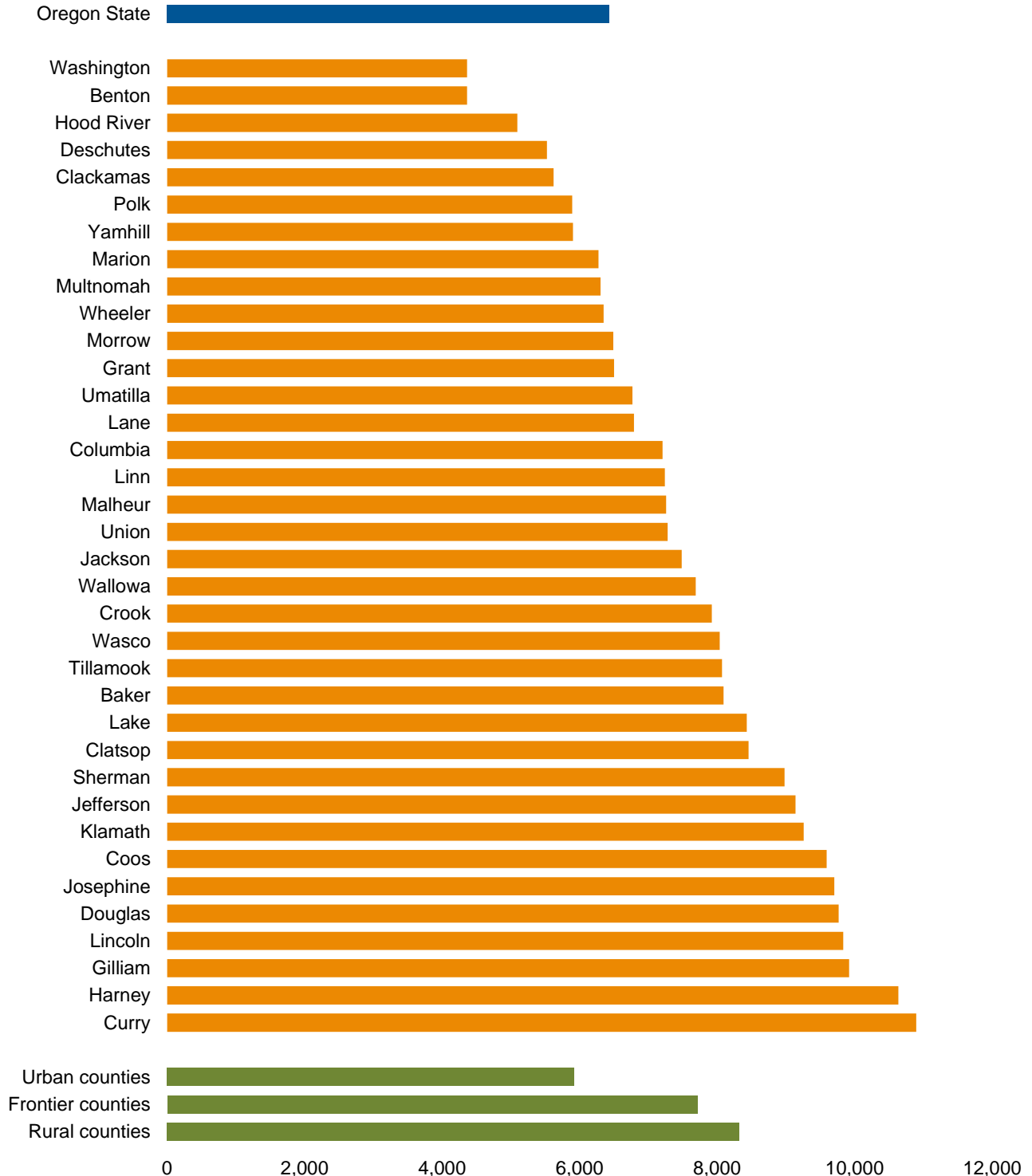


Years of potential life lost (YPLL) before age 75 by county, Oregon, 2012–2016

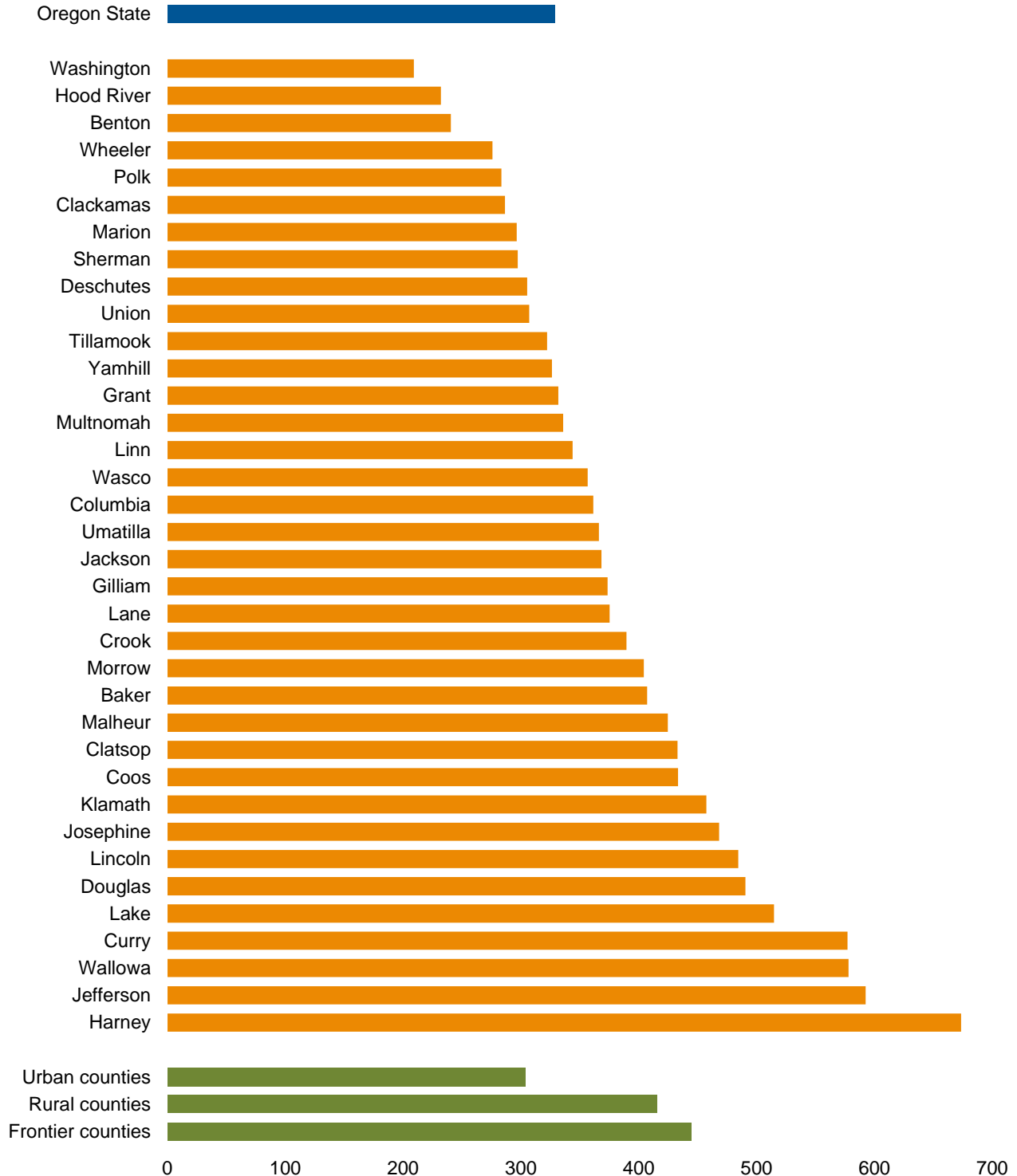

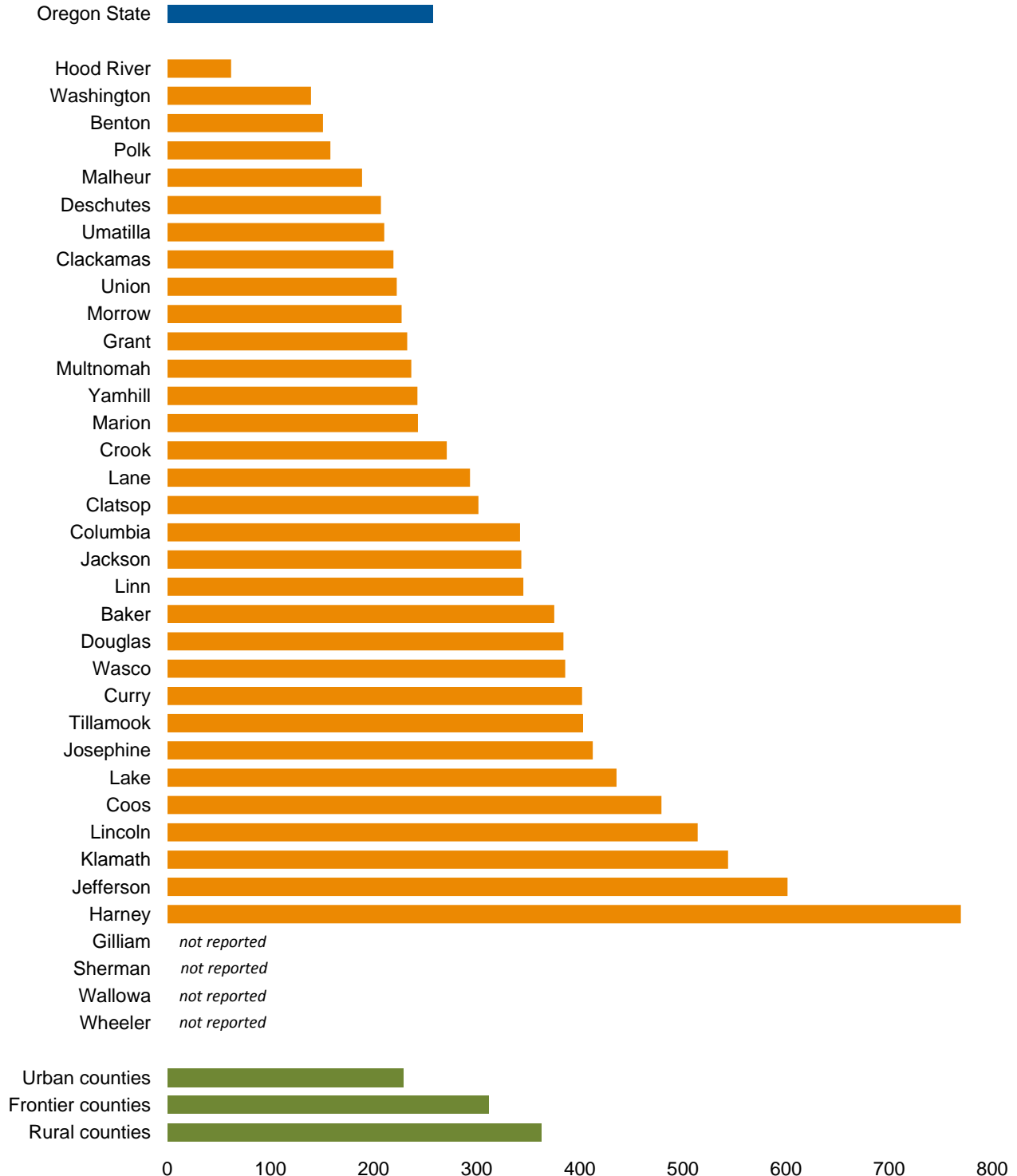

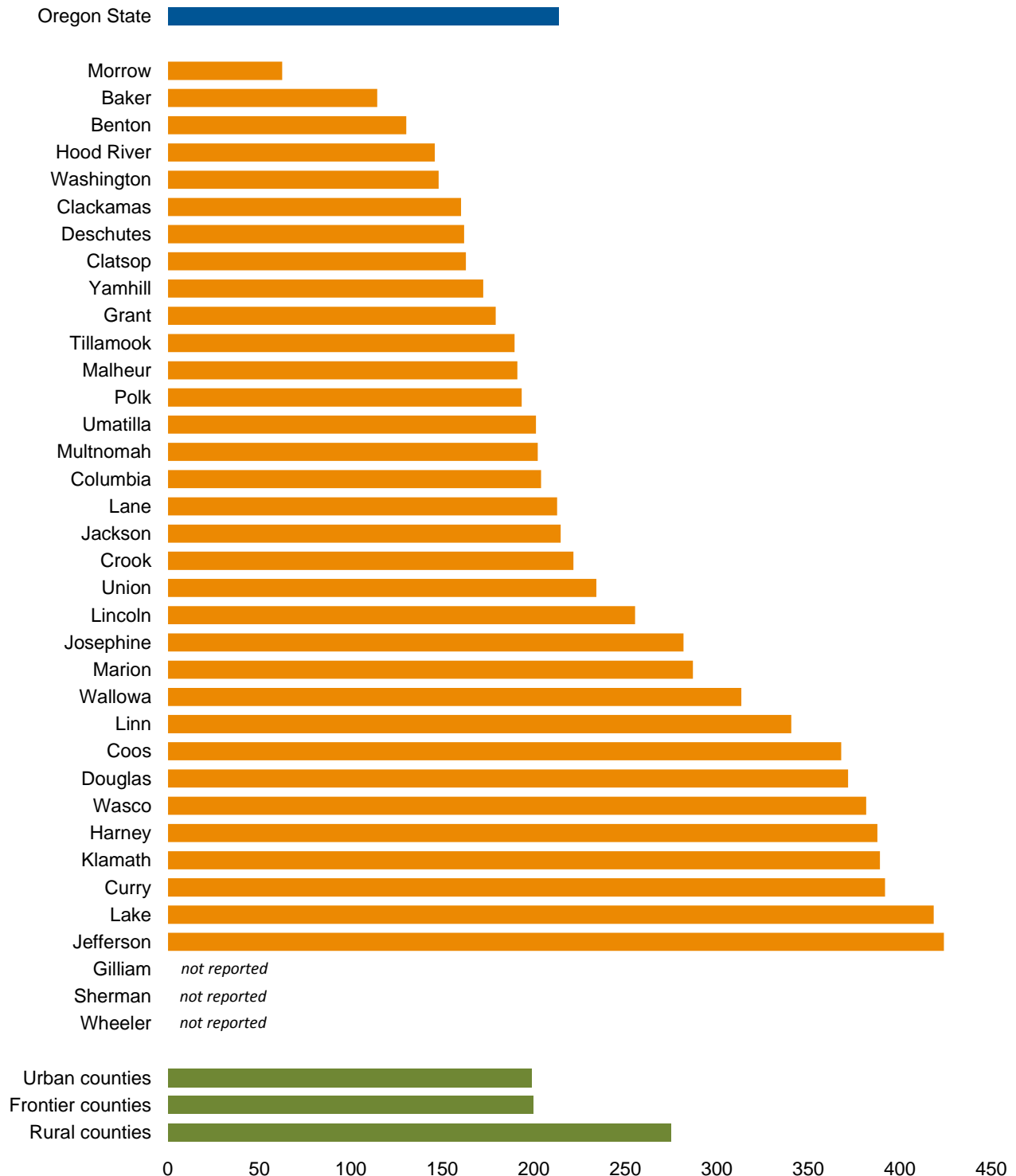

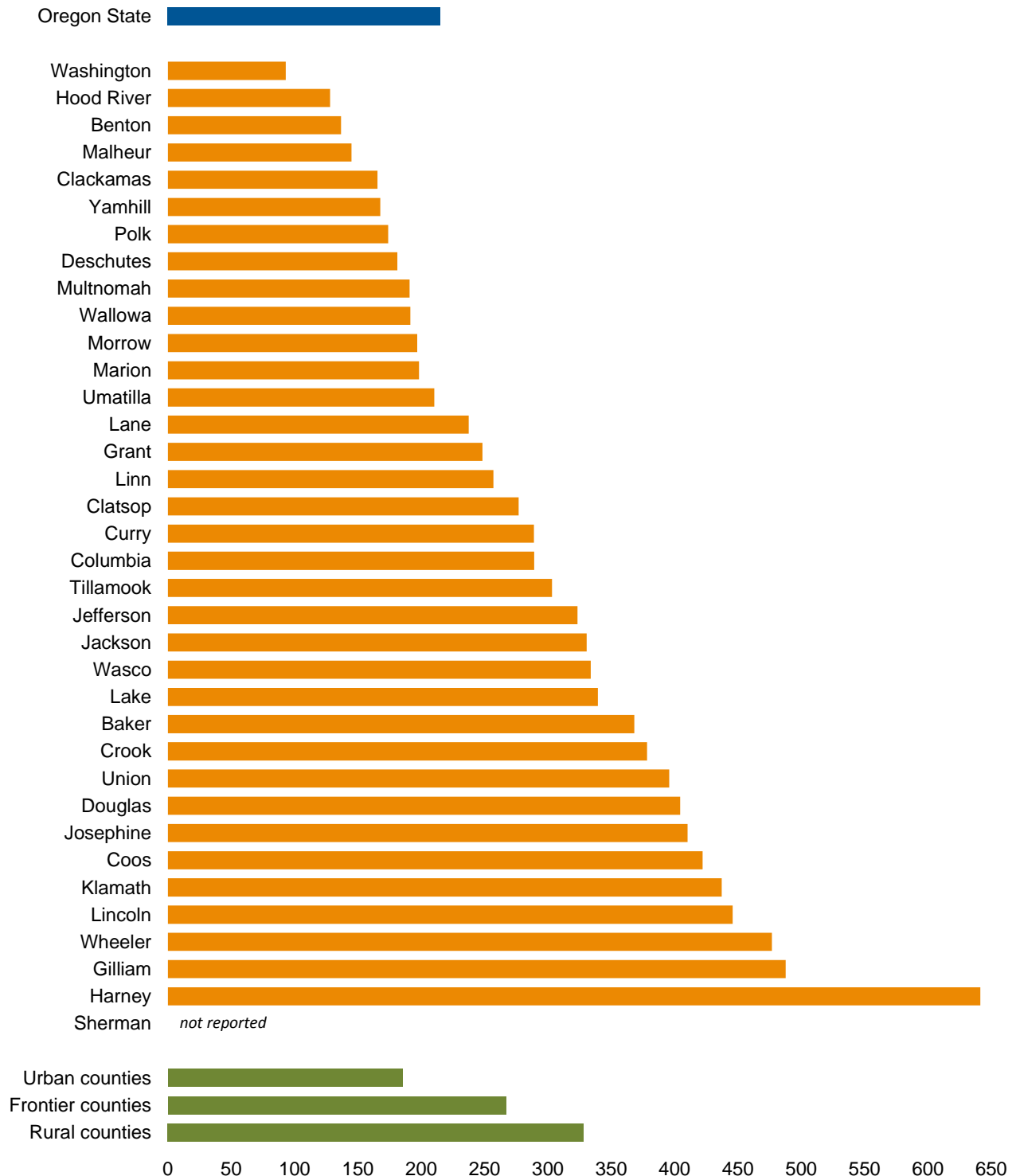
