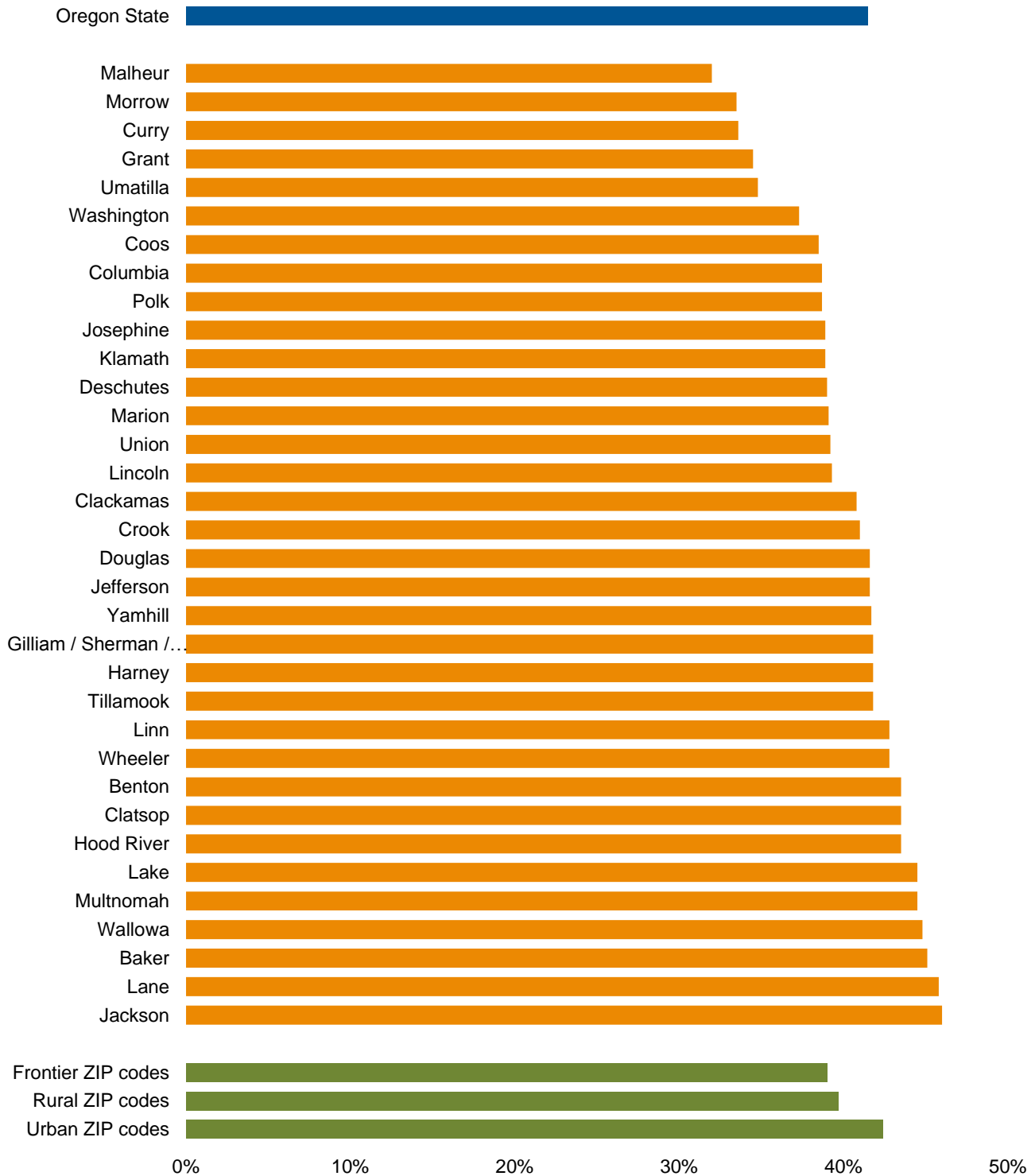


Adults reporting 1 or more days of poor mental health in the past 30 days by county, Oregon, 2012–2015
