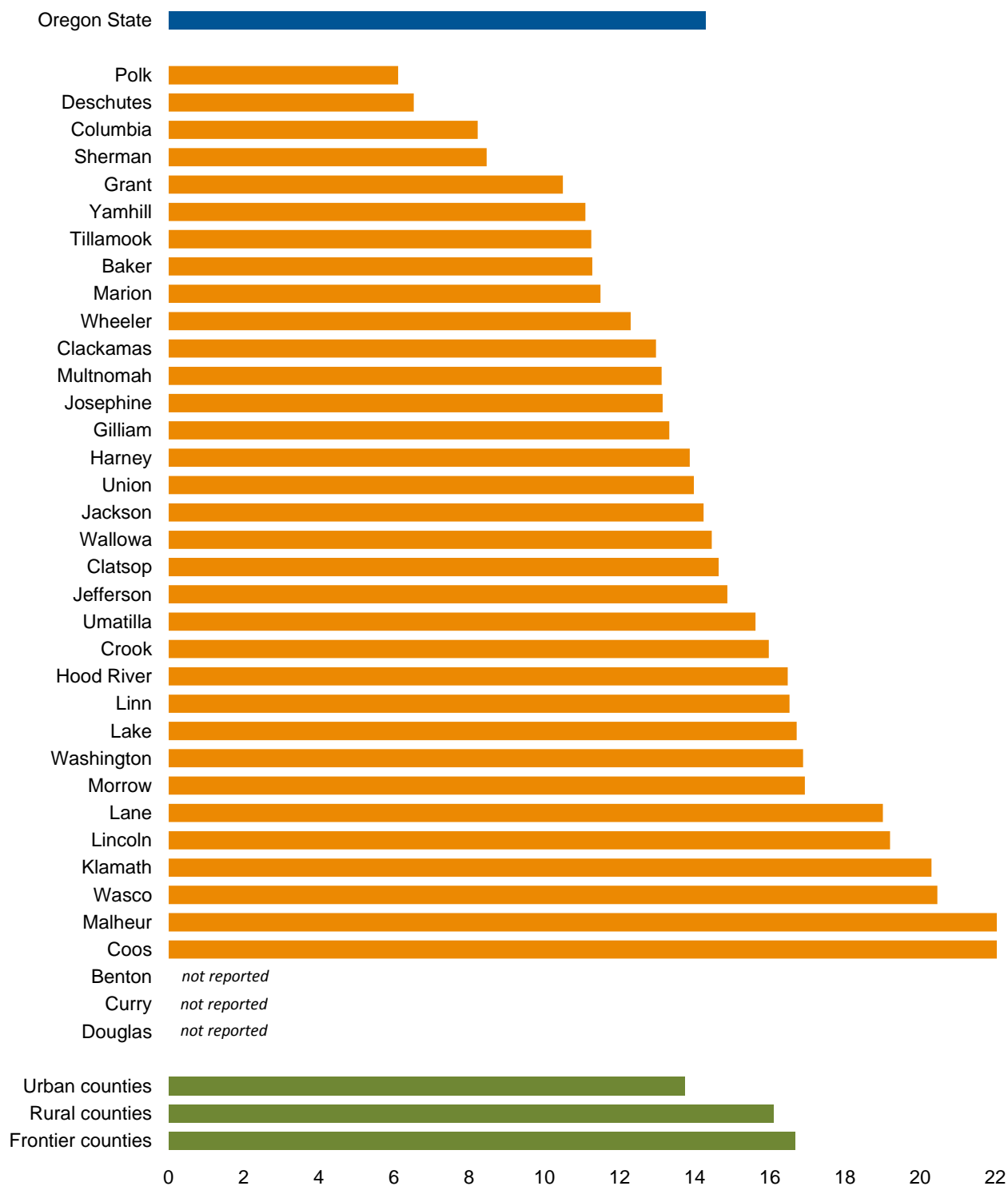


## Teen pregnancy (age 15–17 years) by county, Oregon, 2010–2016

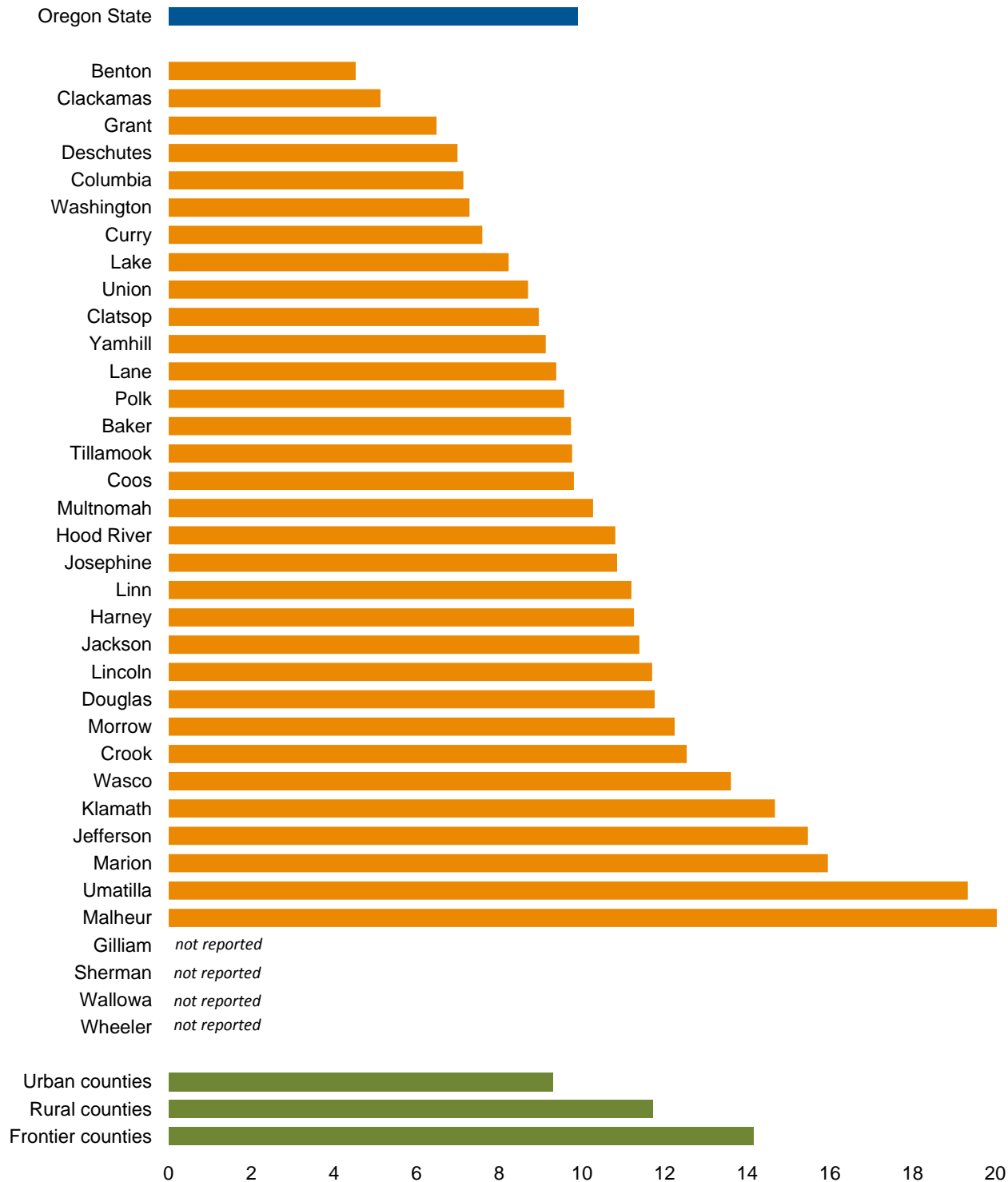
