

Oregon Medical Board
BOARD ACTION REPORT
June 15, 2012

The information contained in this report summarizes new, interim, and final actions taken by the Oregon Medical Board between May 16, 2012 and June 15, 2012.

Scanned copies of Interim Stipulated Orders, Orders of Emergency Suspension, Stipulated Orders, Final Orders, Termination Orders, Modification Orders and Voluntary Limitations are included at the end of this report in the order that they appear in the report. These orders are marked with an * asterisk. **Scanned copies of Corrective Action Agreements and Consent Agreement are not posted, as they are not disciplinary action and impose no practice limitations.** Complaint and Notices of Proposed Disciplinary Action are not listed in this report, as they are not final actions by the Board. Both Orders, however, are public and are available upon request.

On June 6, 2012, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order in which he agreed to not accept any new chronic pain patients, transfer all current chronic pain patients to other providers, discontinue prescribing Schedule II medications or Suboxone within 30 days, and provide the OMB a complete and truthful account of his actions in response to the OMB's request for medical records.

***Haney, Susan Theresa, MD; MD23325; Coos Bay, OR**

On June 12, 2012, the Board issued an Order Terminating Interim Stipulated Order. This Order terminates Licensee's February 22, 2012, Interim Stipulated Order.

***Sachdev, Naina, MD; MD16352; Lake Oswego, OR**

On June 7, 2012, Licensee entered into an Interim Stipulated Order to voluntarily withdraw from practice and place her license in Inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into her ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

1. The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain healthcare providers, including osteopathic physicians, in the state of Oregon. Edward Keim Goering, DO (Licensee) is a licensed osteopathic physician in the state of Oregon.

2.

The Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board initiating an investigation. During the conduct of this investigation, the Board asked Licensee to produce medical charts in regard to six chronic pain patients. Licensee admits that he had medical charts materially altered before they were sent to the Board. This was done with the intent of misleading the Board in regard to the manner of care provided to these patients. Licensee also admits that during the course of the investigation, he provided false and misleading statements to Board investigators. Licensee acknowledges that this was a serious lapse in judgment. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised serious concerns in regards to Licensee's manner of practice and integrity, to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to enter into this Interim Stipulated Order that places restrictions on his license to practice medicine until the investigation is completed.

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3.

In order to address the concerns of the Board, Licensee and the Board agree to enter into this Interim Stipulated Order, which provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions effective the date this Order is signed by Licensee:

3.1 Licensee agrees to give the Board and its Investigator a complete and truthful account of his prior actions and statements in responding to the Board's request for the Licensee's production of his medical records.

3.2 Licensee agrees not to accept any new chronic pain patients and must transfer all of his current chronic pain patients to other medical providers within 30 days from the signing of this Order. For purposes of this Order, "chronic pain patient" is defined to be any patient that received a prescription from Licensee for a Schedule II medication in excess of 30 consecutive days.

3.3 After 30 days from the signing of this Order, Licensee is prohibited from prescribing or dispensing any Schedule II medication or buprenorphine/naloxone (Suboxone) to any patient.

3.4 Licensee must not provide any medical care to any friend or family member.

3.5 Licensee is prohibited from conducting any office based surgery on any patient in his clinic or any other clinic.

3.6 Licensee stipulates and agrees that this Order becomes effective the date it is signed by the Board Chair.

3.7 Licensee must obey all federal and Oregon state laws and regulations pertaining to the practice of medicine

3.8 Licensee understands that violating any term of this Order will be grounds for disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

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4.

At the conclusion of the Board's investigation, Licensee's status will be reviewed in an expeditious manner. Following that review, if the Board determines that the Interim Stipulated Order should remain in effect; Licensee may request a hearing to contest that decision.

5.

This Order is issued by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.265(1) and (2) for the purpose of protecting the public, and making a complete investigation in order to fully inform itself with respect to the performance or conduct of the Licensee and Licensee's ability to safely and competently practice medicine. Pursuant to ORS 677.425, Board investigative materials are confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure. However, as a stipulation this Order is a public document and is reportable to the National Practitioners Data Bank and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Date Bank (HIPDB) and the Federation of State Boards.

This Order becomes effective the date it is signed by the Licensee.

The Oregon Medical Board (Board) is the state agency responsible for licensing, regulating and disciplining certain healthcare providers, including physicians, in the state of Oregon. Naina Sachdev, MD (Licensee) is a licensed physician in the state of Oregon.

2.

The Board received credible information regarding Licensee that resulted in the Board initiating an investigation. The results of the Board's investigation to date have raised concerns to the extent that the Board believes it necessary that Licensee agree to cease the practice of medicine until the investigation is completed.

3.

In order to address the concerns of the Board, Licensee and the Board agree to enter into this Interim Stipulated Order, which provides that Licensee shall comply with the following conditions effective the date this Order is signed by Licensee:

3.1 Licensee voluntarily withdraws from the practice of medicine and her license is placed in Inactive status pending the completion of the Board's investigation into her ability to safely and competently practice medicine.

3.2 Licensee understands that violating any term of this Order will be grounds for disciplinary action under ORS 677.190(17).

3.3 Licensee must notify the Oregon Medical Board within 10 days as to how patients may access or obtain their medical records.

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4.

At the conclusion of the Board's investigation, Licensee's status will be reviewed in an expeditious manner. Following that review, if the Board determines that Licensee shall not be permitted to return to the practice of medicine, Licensee may request a hearing to contest that decision.

5.

This Order is issued by the Board pursuant to ORS 677.265(1) and (2) for the purpose of protecting the public, and making a complete investigation in order to fully inform itself with respect to the performance or conduct of the Licensee and Licensee's ability to safely and competently practice medicine. Pursuant to ORS 677.425, Board investigative materials are confidential and shall not be subject to public disclosure. However, as a stipulation this Order is a public document and is reportable to the National Practitioners Data Bank and the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Data Bank (HIPDB) and the Federation of State Boards.
