Welcome and Introductions (Gretchen Koch)	Review of handouts: August 26, 2016 NPC Agenda; The RN or LPN Who Participates in Vascular and Non-Vascular Access and Infusion Therapy; Sedation and the Nurses Scope of Practice; Interpretive Statement RN Delegation Process in Community Based Settings.
The RN or LPN Who Participates in Vascular and Non-Vascular Access and Infusion Therapy (Wendy)	Wendy Bigelow provided an overview/background information and led a discussion of inclusion of current standards to the interpretive statement. A national Scope of Practice handout entitled "CVC Nursing Scope of Practice – August, 2013) was provided to all present. The committee worked through the entire draft and recommended a few edits which included moving references to the end of the document. Gretchen will incorporate the edits. The draft will then be distributed to NPC members. Gretchen will discuss the document with Board Members during her environmental scan at the November 17, 2016 Public Board Meeting.
Sedation and the RN's Scope of Practice (Gretchen)	Due to the lack of subcommittee members in attendance, NPC members will review the Sedation and the RN's Scope of Practice document to discuss at the next NPC meeting on October 28, 2016.
Interpretive Statement RN Delegation Process in Community Based Settings (Deborah Cateora)	The group provided suggestions for edits to the draft document and an in-depth discussion ensued. It became apparent that the depth and volume of the draft document's content didn't fit well with an interpretive statement format. The decision was made by the subcommittee that refocusing their efforts on a document that would be educational in nature would be more beneficial. The decision was made for the subcommittee to examine the current DHS delegation self-study module (posted on the Board's website) and to draft supporting content and possible post test questions that could augment that document. The subcommittee is scheduled to meet following today's meeting and will begin work on this.
