It incorporates a kayak/paddleboard heat from Lyons Ferry Marina (LFM) to Lyons Ferry State Park (LFSP), followed by an open water swim across Lake Bryan from LFSP to LFM. The kayak/paddleboard event is 0.7 mile across the river; the swim is the same distance return. River traffic will be constantly monitored. Participants will register online in advance of the event or the day of at LFSP. Authorized participants begin the event from the breakwater at LFM and the swim immediately follows (relay style) in flights of 10 swimmers. A safety flotilla (of personal watercraft) will provide assistance and mark the paddling/swimming lane. A PADI certified rescue diver and medical doctor will be on course.
