The proposed rule will enable a Charter Boat operator to register, pay a fee for either a single year or biennial license.

Guide Advisory Committee and Charter Boat Sub-Committee meeting minutes from February - April 2016 meetings.

Rule documents are available for public inspection at the Oregon State Marine Board, Director's Office between 8:30 am - 4:00 pm on normal working days, Monday-Friday.

Fiscal and Economic Impact:

The availability to register and purchase a biennial Charter Boat license may reduce the administrative burden for the owner/operator and agency.

Statement of Cost of Compliance:

1. Impact on state agencies, units of local government and the public (ORS 183.335(2)(b)(E)):

The proposed change to establish a biennial Charter license fee may provide administrative processing cost savings to the agency.
