#### Veterinary Dentistry 875-015-0050

(a) Where preventive dental cleanings are offered, appropriate polishing equipment shall be available. (Preventive veterinary dental procedures include removal of calculus, soft deposits, plaque, and stains, or the smoothing, filing, or polishing of tooth surfaces.)

(b) Dental diagnostic radiograph capability shall be available when surgical dental services are offered. (A veterinary dental operation/procedure is the application or use of any instrument or device to any portion of an animal's tooth, gum or related tissue for the prevention, cure, relief of any wound, fracture, injury, disease or other condition of an animal's tooth, gum or related tissue.)

(c) Records of dental work performed shall be kept and become part of the animal's permanent record.
