

## Social Security Number Requirement, Authority and Disclosure Statement

As part of your application for an initial, renewed, or reinstated professional license issued by the Oregon Physical Therapist Licensing Board (PT Board), you are required to provide your Social Security Number (SSN) to the PT Board. The authority for this requirement is provided by ORS 25.785, ORS 305.385 USC § 405(c)(2)(C)(i), USC § 666(a)(13). Failure to provide your SSN will be a basis for the PT Board to refuse to issue, renew, or reinstate the license. Although a number other than your SSN appears on the face of the license, your SSN will remain on file with the PT Board. If warranted, your SSN may be used for background checks, child support enforcement, federal and state tax administration, and the reporting of final disciplinary actions against your PT / PTA license to the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB). Any other use of your SSN will require your written authorization.
