## Our Vision:

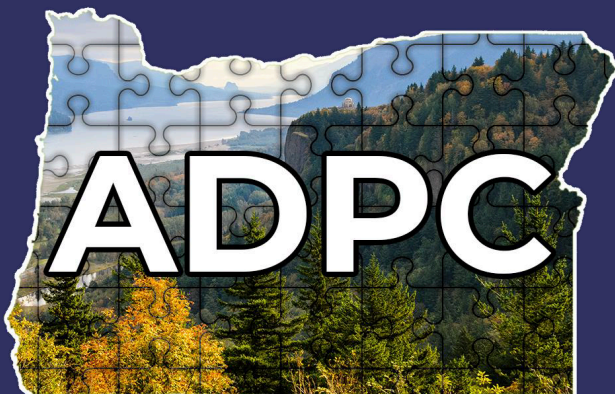
### A Recovery-Oriented System of Care

The Oregon Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission (ADPC) has developed forward-looking priorities through its five core committees to guide the state's Comprehensive Plan for addressing substance use from 2026 to 2030. These priorities emphasize health equity, access, coordination, and evidence-based and tribal-based interventions to create a fully integrated system of care grounded in policies, practices, and principles that ensure all Oregonians can access support and services wherever they are.

### Collective Action Towards Outcomes

Our priorities aim to increase **access** across the continuum of care to achieve:

- Reduction in the **prevalence** of Substance Use Disorders
- Reduction in **substance use-related death**
- Reduction in **substance use-related disparities and inequities**
