A robust, culturally appropriate, recovery-oriented system is available to all Oregonians who need it.

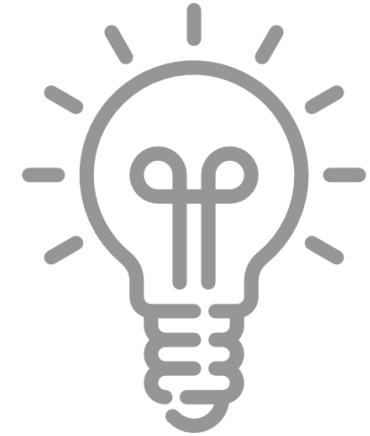


Accessible
