

County-level data for ADPC Committees

The maps on the following pages are shaded to represent different levels of overdose deaths, hospital overdose visits for opioids and stimulants, and emergency department visits for opioids and stimulants. Both overall counts and rates are provided in separate charts. Counts and rates are averages over a 4-year period. This is to include smaller counties where a rate can't be published for single years due to confidentiality and unreliability.

For the maps representing counts, in each case the weight, or darker color, is on Multnomah County, its surrounding counties, and Lane County. This is because population is centered in these areas.

The maps colored by rates allow for better comparison between counties with different population levels. For rates of overdose death, counties with higher rates include Multnomah, Lane, Curry, and Josephine. Many counties are striped or grayed and no rates are available for these counties. These counties had rates or counts low enough to where an individual could potentially be identified, breaching confidentiality.

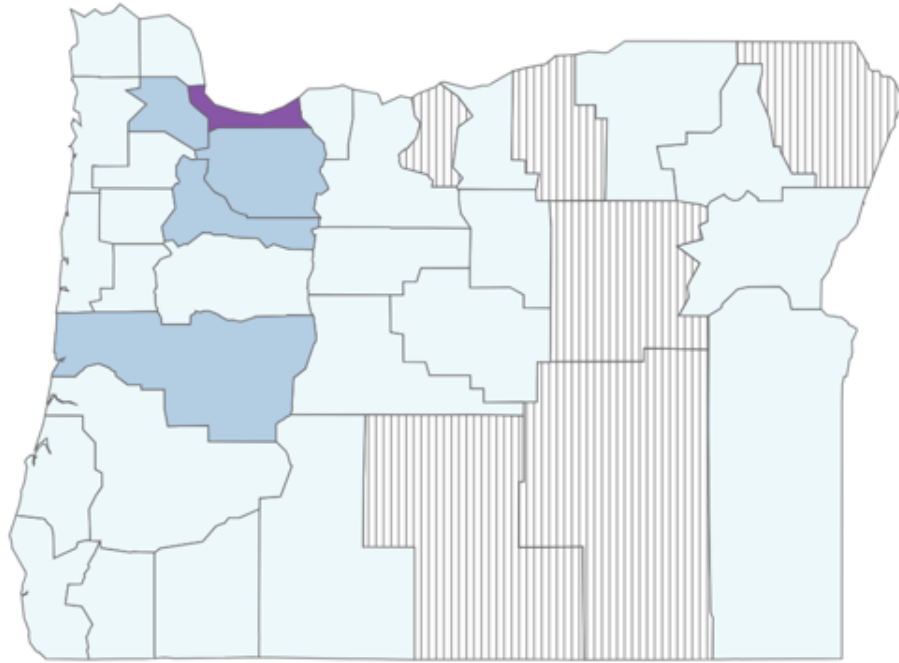
For hospital opioid overdose visits, rates were high in the western part of the state, as well as in Central Oregon. An identifiable region with high rates can be seen on the Coast, and in Josephine County in particular. For stimulants, Lane County stood out, along with Coos, Curry, and Multnomah.

For emergency department opioid overdose visits, high rates were once again present in Western Oregon, but Central Oregon stood out as the area with the highest rates. Similarly, for stimulants, rates were high in Central Oregon, and in Union County in particular.

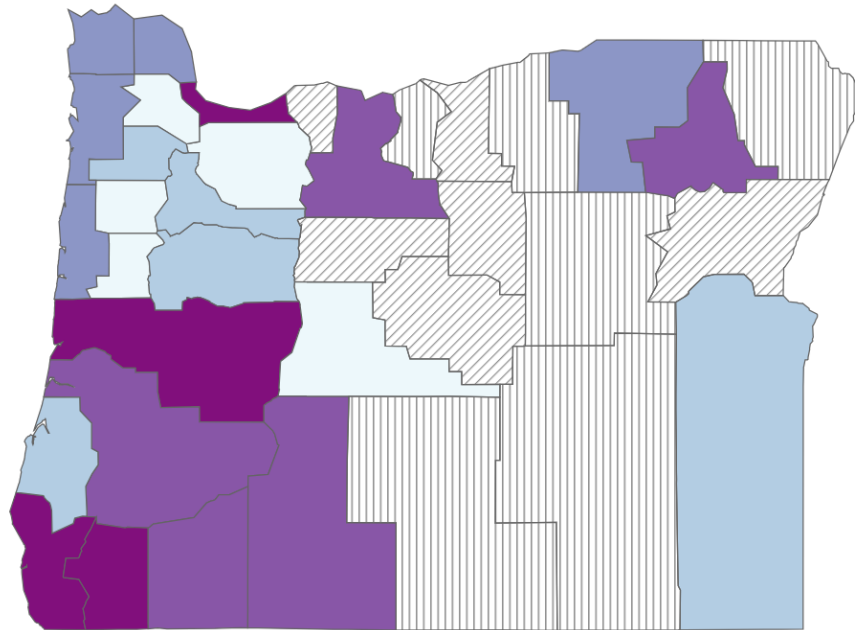

Overdose Death Rate Per 100k, 2019-2022

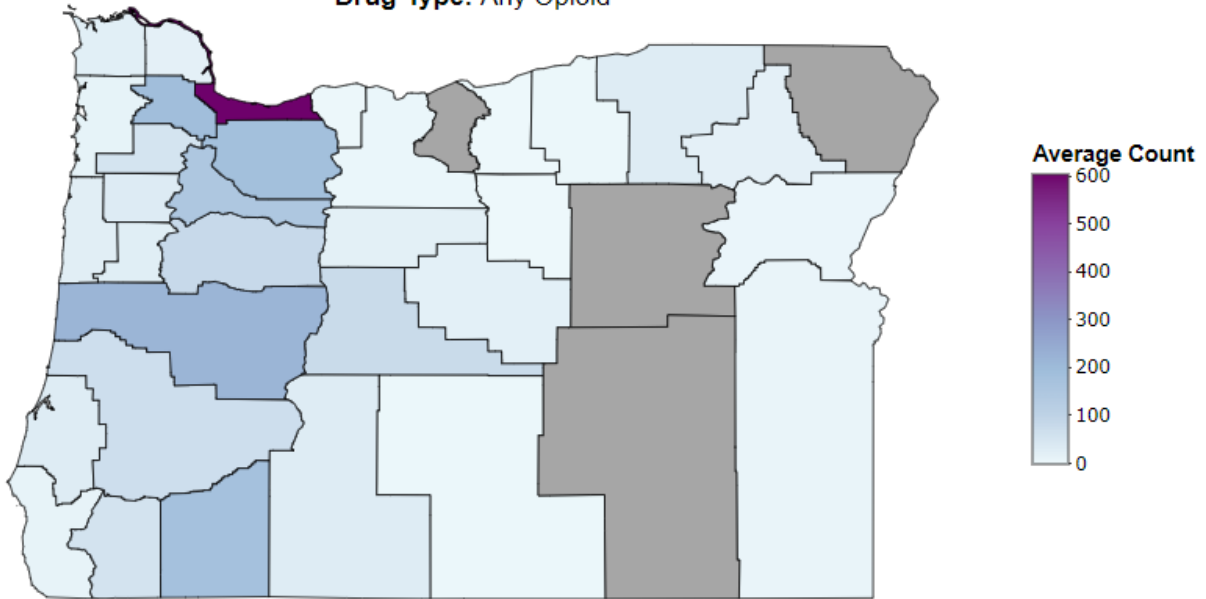

Drug Type: Any Opioid



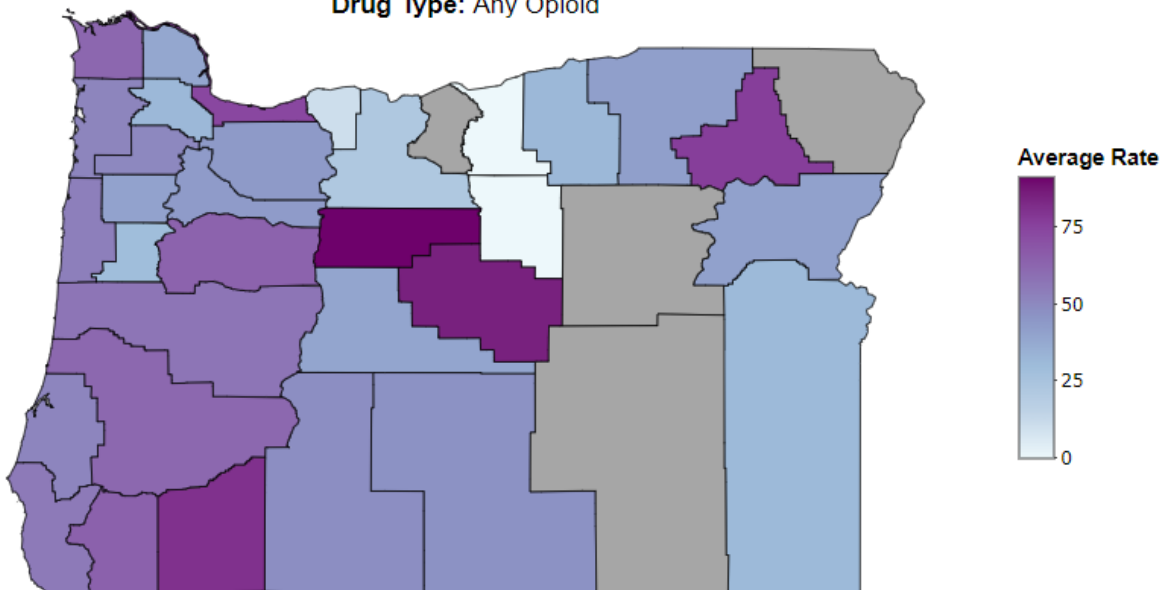

Drug Type: Any Opioid



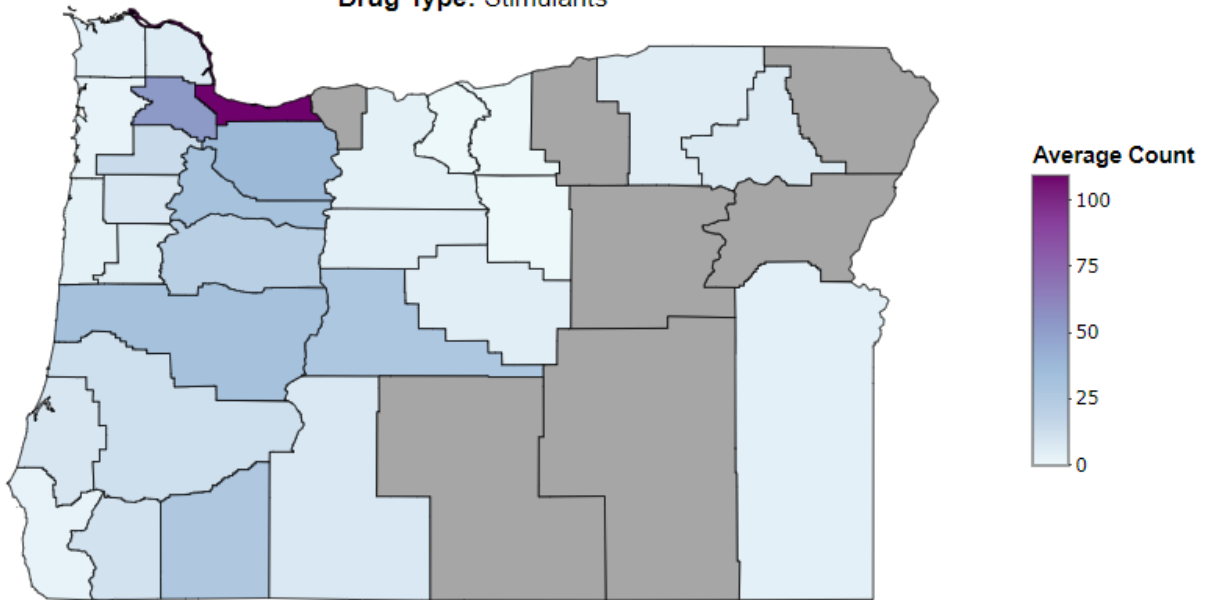

Drug Type: Stimulants



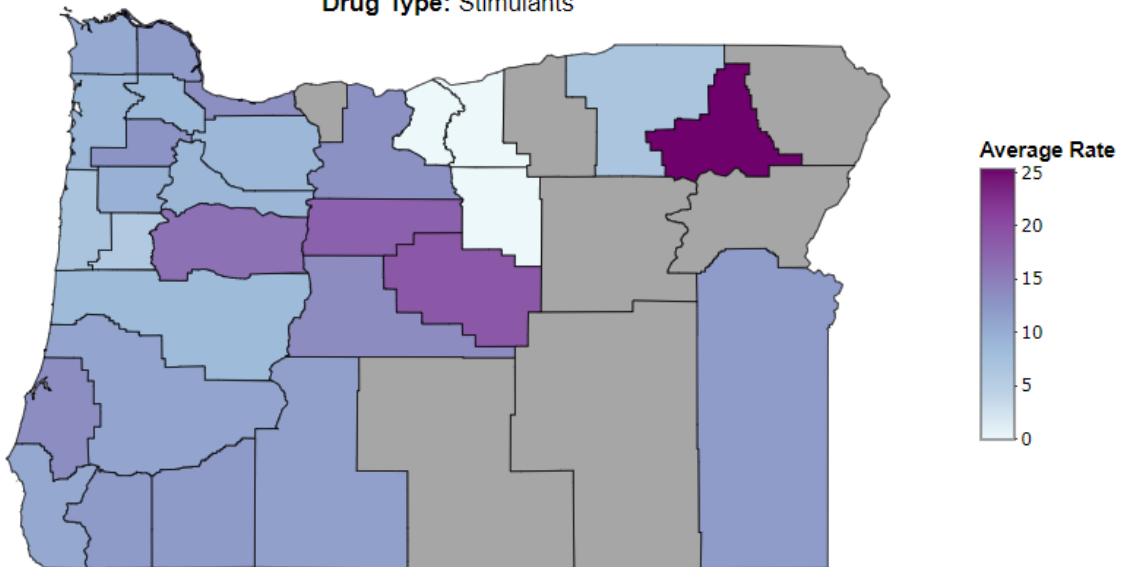
