Presented by Director Dolph

Committee Nomination

ACTION ITEM:

Co-Chair Jokinen presented a nomination for Beth Williams, Assistant Professor in the Department of Medicine, Division of Internal Medicine and Geriatrics at OHSU. A motion to approve the nomination was made by Heather Jefferis and seconded by Joe Bazeghi. The motion passed unanimously.

Partner Presentation: Reentry Healthcare Program

Presented by Amber Cheney, OHA

Background: OHP Reentry Health Care

The Oregon Health Authority is developing a program to help people access health care as they leave jail, prison, or youth facilities. Many individuals lose their health coverage while incarcerated, which makes it difficult to get medical or mental health care when they return to the community. The new Oregon Health Plan (OHP) Reentry Health Care program will provide eligible people with limited OHP benefits before they are released, helping them connect to doctors, medications, and support services right away. The goal is to improve health outcomes, reduce gaps in care, and support a safer, healthier reentry into the community.

Starting Jan 1, 2026: OHA started implementing changes to eligibility and enrollment processes to support identification and enrollment for the Youth to connect with their CCO/Acentra and gain access to post-release services within 30 days.

OHA will support pre-release eligibility and enrollment processes with carceral facilities no later than early 2027. The presentation provided information about currently eligible facilities and discussed that the current process is one of voluntary participation.

Priority Setting: Withdrawal Management

Presented by Mitch Doig, ADPC

Mitch Doig led a discussion on withdrawal management as a priority area. The committee discussed the need for clearer access to safe and timely withdrawal management services across communities and noted that improving these services will support better treatment outcomes.

Comprehensive Plan: Community Provider Survey for WM settings (Working Item)

Presented by Co-Chair Jokinen and Co-Chair Bucheit

Co-Chair Jokinen will be presenting on this item at our next meeting on April 8th, 2026. Committee members requested discussion questions be sent as follow up.
