Subj: 2019/2020 COAR Grant Projects

The 2019/2020 COAR Grant Cycle has completed the Aviation Review Committee (ARC) phase pursuant to ORS 319.020(3)(a) and (b).

The department received 40 total applications totaling ~\$4.5 Million.

Priority I Applications: 21 for \$1,959,433
Priority II Applications: 6 for \$779,500
Priority III Applications: 13 for \$1,766,000

Staff has provided the following appendices for your review.

Appendix A contains the recommended projects list for Priority I, II and III for the 2019/2020 COAR Grant Cycle.

The Aviation Review Committee recommended no funding for the following projects:

Priority II
COAR-2020-3S8-00045
COAR-2020-SPB-00031
Priority III
COAR-2020-6K5-00049

The Aviation Review Committee found that during the review of the statutory considerations the above named projects did not contain enough information in their applications to support a favorable recommendation. The recommendation for no funding is based on the considerations and that the applications scored zero or negative points in the ARC review.

- The State Aviation Board may direct staff to invite those airport managers, with projects not recommended for funding, to answer questions specific to their application materials at the board meeting. Staff's recommendation is that airport managers invited to speak, only speak on the materials contained within the application. Any information outside of the application material would not be permissible without additional review of the ARC.

The Aviation Review Committee found that the rest of the projects should be forwarded to the State Aviation Board for approval and funding.
