2022/2023 COAR Grant Cycle

- The 2022/2023 COAR grant cycle is the 7th grant cycle since the inception of the Aviation System Action Program (ASAP).
- Funding for this cycle will be the second to include revenues previously earmarked for the ROAR program. The additional monies will allow for potential funding of the Priority 3 grants, which are generally economic development projects that assist primarily rural, non-NPIAS airports.
- This was also the second cycle in which the ACT grading was done in cohorts in a Zoom meeting (pairs of reviewers with 7-8 grants to review) rather than individually, a change that has been well received by the ARC members.
- The maximum grant request was increased by the State Aviation Board from \$150k to \$250k for COAR cycle 7 only.
