Aurora plane crash pilot identified

AURORA, Ore. -- Investigators have identified the pilot who was injured after his experimental aircraft crashed into a hangar at Aurora Airport on Saturday.

Crews said Kevin Carr, 53, of Vancouver, Wash. was flying his plane when it crashed into the roof of the hangar at around 5:45 p.m. Carr was extricated from the wreckage and taken by air ambulance to OHSU, where he is listed in critical condition.

The aircraft is registered as a 1996 Savage-Cozy plane, which fire crews said is an experimental aircraft.

No one else was in the plane, and no other injuries were reported. The FAA continues to investigate the crash.
