Update: Siletz Bay State Airport Runway Closure
Starting June 16th, 2025
Update: The Siletz Bay State Airport (S45) Runway and Electrical Rehabilitation Project will resume Monday June 16th. We expect the runway and taxiways to be closed for approximately 60 days while this work is being done.
This project will resurface the aging north 2/3rds of the runway, as well as the low portions on the south end. It will also replace the nearly 40 year old airfield electrical system.

Update: Cottage Grove State Airport - Apron Rehab Project - Starting June 2nd
Update: The Cottage Grove State Airport (61S) Apron Rehabilitation project will begin June 2nd, 2025. Click learn more for phasing schedule.
This project will repave the main apron and tie down area, which will be completed in two phases over 90 days. This phased approach will minimize impacts to tenants and maintain access to the runway and taxiways, as well as the 100LL fuel tank.
