Oregon Department of aviation Board Meeting, In support for Pacific City State Airport!!!

The ODAV Board met on September 3rd to discuss whether to claw back the \$1.375 million SOAR funding for the airport. They believe that the airport is encroached and therefore is unsafe. There has not been even one fatality at the airport for 75 years!!

At the start of the Sept Board meeting, it was reported that they had received 50 letters of support, and 3 advocates for the airport made public comments asking for funding to continue. 42 people participated in the Team virtual meeting. We sent a clear message that we want the funding to continue! However, they Board delayed the funding decision until their October 1st meeting.

I, Kimber Brandon do hereby ask for your attention on this matter.

We're asking, in this email for SOAR funding to fix the broken drainage system, put in an emergency access road, and expand the airplane parking area. This project cannot be broken up into phases because of impending FEMA rule changes that will greatly impact the ability to work on the airport after October 2027.

I am a sport pilot in training. This means I'm a student going for my license. I want the opportunity to fly to this wonderful airport to continue for my self and others around me. This airport being close to restaurants and other activities means a fun day will be had. We can walk the shores and spend the day here having fun. To get a group of pilots together to fly in for the day and have amenities close is a wonderful opportunity for a great day. Please keep this airport open and available.
