9 **PROCEDURAL HISTORY**

10 On June 26, 2013, pursuant to ORS 455.895(1)(b) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Electrical and
11 Elevator Board (Board) served Respondent a Citation for License or Registration Violations, Notice
12 of Civil Penalty, Citation #16354 for civil penalties totaling \$3,000. The citation identified a
13 violation of ORS 479.620(1). The Notice offered Respondent an opportunity for hearing, if
14 requested within 20 days of the date of service.

15 Respondent timely requested a hearing on July 9, 2013 and the hearing was scheduled for 9:00 a.m.
16 on November 6, 2013. Respondent did not appear for the hearing.

17 After considering the agency file in this matter, the Board enters the following order:

18 **FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSION OF LAW**

19 (1) On or about June 20, 2013, Respondent, who does not possess an electrical
20 contractor's license, advertised on the World Wide Web (craigslist.com) as being in the business of
21 performing electrical installations, in violation of ORS 479.620(1).

22 (2) On or about June 26, 2013, at 16855 SW Somes Lane, Beaverton, Oregon, you agreed
23 to install a new light fixture, outlet and associated electrical wiring for \$35 dollars per hour, for the
24 account of another, without a valid electrical contractor's license, in violation of ORS 479.620(1).

25 (3) The installation of new light fixture, outlet and associated electrical wiring are
electrical installations under ORS 479.530(10).

26 **ORDER**


27 Under ORS 455.895(1)(b) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Board assesses the following sanctions:

28 (1) a \$3,000 civil penalty for violating ORS 479.620(1)

1 **NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW (COURT OF APPEALS)**

2 You are entitled to judicial review of this Order pursuant to ORS 183.482. Judicial review may be
3 initiated by filing a petition for review with the Oregon Court of Appeals within 60 days from the
4 date this order was mailed to you.
