

1 **ORDER**

2 Under ORS 455.895(1)(a) and OAR 918-001-0036, the Board assesses the following
3 sanction:

- 4 1. \$2,000 civil penalty for violating ORS 693.030(2)(a)

5 **NOTICE OF RIGHT TO HEARING**

6 Respondent is entitled to a hearing as provided by the Administrative Procedures Act,
7 Oregon Revised Statutes, chapter 183. If Respondent requests a hearing, the request must be in
8 writing and postmarked no later than 20 days from the date of service. If the Notice was served on
9 Respondent in person, the date of service is the date Respondent received the Notice. If the Notice
10 was served through the mail, the date of service is the day the Notice was mailed, not the day it was
11 received by the Respondent. If a request for hearing is not received within the 20-day period,
12 Respondent's right to a hearing shall be considered waived unless the failure to request a hearing
13 was beyond Respondent's reasonable control. Hearing requests shall be mailed to Building Codes
14 Division, Enforcement Section, P.O. Box 14470, Salem, Oregon, 97309.

15 Respondent has the right to be represented by legal counsel. ORS 183.457 provides that a
16 corporation may be represented by an authorized representative at the hearing. If Respondent
17 requests a hearing the Board and Director will notify Respondent of the time and place of the
18 hearing. The Board and Director will give Respondent information on the procedures, right of
19 representation and other rights of parties relating to the conduct of the hearing before
20 commencement of the hearing.
