



1 3.2 At all relevant times, Respondent was employed by Vivint as a Limited Energy  
2 Technician, and was responsible to make electrical installations related to the installation of  
3 burglar systems on behalf of Vivint.

4 3.3 On multiple occasions from at least May 9, 2013 to at least May 18, 2013, Respondent  
5 allowed unlicensed individuals to run electrical wire through interior walls, or through  
6 raceways attached to interior walls, during the installation of burglar alarm systems on  
7 behalf of Vivint and under minor label permits signed by Respondent.

8 3.4 Installing electrical wire through interior walls, or through raceways attached to interior  
9 walls, is an electrical installation as defined by ORS 479.530(10).

10 4.

11 The Director finds, but Respondent does not admit, that by allowing the individuals listed  
12 above to perform electrical work for which those individuals were not properly registered or licensed  
13 under minor label permits signed by Respondent, Respondent violated OAR 918-282-0120(1) on  
14 multiple occasions.

15 5.

16 The Director hereby assesses a \$3,000 civil penalty against Respondent for violating OAR 918-  
17 282-0120(1) on multiple occasions, \$1,000 of which will be stayed for a period of two years from  
18 issuance of this Consent Order, under the terms of this order. If Respondent fully complies with all  
19 terms of this Consent Order, the stayed amount of the civil penalty shall be considered satisfied at the  
20 end of two years. Respondent shall pay the \$2,000 of civil penalty that has not been stayed, to the  
21 Department of Consumer and Business Services – Building Codes Division, no later than July 25,  
22 2015.<sup>1</sup> If Respondent fails to fully and timely comply with any term of this Consent Order, the \$1,000  
23 of the civil penalty that has been stayed shall be immediately due and payable.

1 6.

2 Respondent shall fully cooperate with the Agency's enforcement efforts in cases against other  
3 entities or individuals that rely on the underlying facts in this case.

4 7.

5 Respondent shall not commit any new violations of the Agency's statutes or rules.

6 8.

7 Respondent understands that any violation of the terms of this Consent Order will also result in  
8 further enforcement action.

9 9.

10 Respondent understands and agrees that any violation of the Agency's statutes or rules not  
11 alleged in this order, whether committed before or after the execution of this Consent Order, may result  
12 in additional enforcement action. However, and notwithstanding the foregoing, this Consent Order  
13 fully and finally resolves any and all potential violations of OAR 918-282-0120(1) by Respondent in  
14 connection with the installation or repair of a burglar alarm system that may have occurred before July  
15 29, 2014.

16 10.

17 Respondent understands that failure to comply with this Consent Order may result in the denial  
18 of future licensing applications, suspension of licensing or certification issued by the Agency and other  
19 state agencies, or both.

20 11.

21 Respondent has read and fully understands the terms of this Consent Order, freely and  
22 voluntarily consents to the entry of this order without further hearing, without any coercion, force or  
23 duress, and expressly waives all rights to hearing, appeal or judicial review in this matter.


