An individual's scope of work will be restricted based on certification and experience. The division will designate the scope of work allowed based on an applicant's experience. License applicants must obtain the appropriate certification recognized under OAR 918-098-1010 through 918-098-1220. In addition to obtaining the appropriate certification under chapter 918, division 098, to perform plan reviews and inspections on structures, license applicants must demonstrate to the division at least one of the following:  1. Two years of construction or inspection-related experience or its equivalent  2. An approved one-year, inspection-related program and one year of construction or inspection-related experience  3. A degree from a division-approved, two-year, inspection-related program or its equivalent  4. An Oregon registration as an architect, an Oregon-certified professional engineer, or a bachelor's or master's degree in architecture, civil, or structural engineering.
