

Residential Certificate of Lighting Fixtures

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INTRODUCTION

The Oregon Residential Specialty Code (ORSC) Section N1107 requires that all permanently installed lighting fixtures of a dwelling unit and guest rooms within residential buildings be "high efficiency light sources."

ORSC Section N1102 defines "high efficiency light source" as compact fluorescent lamps, T-8 or smaller diameter linear fluorescent lamps, LED lamps, fixture-integrated illumination devices, or other lamp types with an efficacy not less than 65 lumens per watt for each lamp or luminaires with an efficacy not less than 45 lumens per watt for each luminaire.

ORSC Sections N1107 and N1101.4 require a contractor, builder, or owner to notify the building official that the requirements for high efficiency light sources have been complied with. Notification must be submitted no later than the final inspection. This form must be used to provide notification to the building official.
