WHAT THE LAW SAYS

(1) Under ORS 479.620(1), unless exempted under ORS 479.540, a person may engage in the business of making electrical installations without an electrical contractor's license.¹

(2) Under ORS 47.550(1), unless exempted under ORS 479.540, a person may not work on any new electrical installation for which a permit has not been obtained.

(3) Under OAR 918-282-0120, no person or entity may allow any individual to perform electrical work for which the individual is not properly registered or licensed.

(4) Under ORS 479.620(3), unless exempted under ORS 479.540, no person may make an electrical installation without a supervising or journeyman electrician's license.

STIPULATED AGREEMENT

The parties agree to resolve this matter, without a hearing, by the entry of this Consent Order subject to the following terms and conditions:

(1) The Board hereby assesses civil penalties against Respondent totaling \$6,000 for the violations listed above, but suspends \$4,250 of the civil penalty assessed for a period of five years under the following terms:

(1.1) Respondent agrees to pay the remaining \$1,750 of the civil penalty.

(1.2) Should Respondent submit a full payment of \$1,250 by the invoice due date, the additional \$500 will be suspended. (The invoice will be included with Respondent's copy of the Final Order after it is signed by the Board)

(2) Respondent agrees not to commit further violations of Building Codes Division's statutes or rules.

(3) Respondent understands and agrees any violation of the terms of this Consent Order will result in further enforcement action.

(4) Respondent understands and agrees that any violations of Building Code Division's statutes or rules not alleged in this Order, whether committed before or after the execution of this Consent Order, shall be the basis for further enforcement action.


¹ OAR 918-030-0010(8) states that for purposes of ORS 447.040, 479.620, 480.630 and any other license regulated by ORS chapter 455, "engaging in the business" means to advertise or solicit, contract or agree to perform, or to perform, work for which a license or permit is required under Oregon law, including but not limited to a single instance.

2 (5) Respondent understands the suspended civil penalty will be waived five years after
3 the execution of this Consent Order, provided Respondent complies with its terms and has not
4 committed any further violations of Building Codes Division's statutes or rules.

4 (6) Respondent has read and fully understands the terms of this Consent Order, freely and
5 voluntarily consent to the entry of this Order without further hearing, without any force or
6 duress, and expressly waives all rights to hearing or appeal in this matter.

6 (7) Respondent understands that, upon signature of all parties, this Consent Order will be
7 a FINAL ORDER.
