

1 **ORDER**

2 Under ORS 455.129(2)(b), the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business
3 Services revokes Respondent's electrical contractor license number C579 for violating the Final
4 Order in case number 2013-0001.

4 **NOTICE OF RIGHT TO HEARING**

5 Respondent is entitled to a hearing as provided by the Administrative Procedures Act, Oregon
6 Revised Statutes, chapter 183. If Respondent requests a hearing, the request must be in writing and
7 postmarked no later than 20 days from the service date. If this Notice was served to Respondent in
8 person, the service date is the date Respondent received this Notice. If this Notice was served
9 through the mail, the service date is the day the Notice was mailed, not the day Respondent received
10 it.

11 If a request for hearing is not received by the Building Codes Division with a postmark dated
12 within 20 days, Respondent's rights to a hearing is considered waived. Mail hearing requests to
13 Building Codes Division, Enforcement Section, P.O. Box 14470, Salem, Oregon, 97309.

14 Respondent has the right to be represented by legal counsel. ORS 183.457 provides that a
15 corporation may be represented by an authorized representative at the hearing. If Respondent
16 requests a hearing, Respondent will be notified of the time and place of the hearing and be given
17 information on procedures, right of representation and other rights of parties relating to the hearing
18 before it begins.

14 **NOTICE TO ACTIVE DUTY SERVICE MEMBERS**



NOTICE OF FINAL ORDER

If Respondent does not timely request a hearing, withdraws a hearing request, does not notify the Building Codes Division or the administrative law judge that Respondent will not appear, or fails to appear at a scheduled hearing, the division will issue a Final Order by Default. If the division issues a Final Order by Default, it designates the file, including any materials submitted by Respondent that relate to this matter, as the record for purpose of proving a prima facie case.

Respondent is entitled to judicial review of any final order issued in the matter of this Notice of Proposed Revocation of Electrical Contractor License Number C579. Judicial review may be obtained by filing a petition for review with the Oregon Court of Appeals within 60 days after the Final Order is served. See ORS 183.482. If the Order was served in person, the service date is the date Respondent received the Order. If the Order was served through the mail, the service date is the day the Order was mailed, not the day it was received by Respondent. If Respondent does not file a petition for judicial review within 60 days, Respondent will lose the right to appeal. The phone number for the Oregon Court of Appeals is 503-986-5555.
