## 2010 Solar Installation Specialty Code and Commentary Errata & Clarifications

The following errors, corrections, additions and deletions are noted in the order found in the code book:

Section 101.2.1(Commentary) Added to address questions regarding Public Ways, and Agricultural Ground Mounted Systems.

Section 101.2, Exception #3, add apostrophe to “users” to read “user’s”.

Section 101.3, line 9, deleted “s” from fire fighters.

Section 101.3 (Commentary) corrected spelling of “requires”.

Section 104.2.3 (Commentary) Guidance on meaning of “Public Service Agency” added.

Section 202, Definition of NRTL, deleted “registered” and replace with “recognized”.

Section 302.1 (Commentary) Guidance on solar carports.

Section 303.4 #2, reference to exempt structures under “105.1” replaced with correct citation to “105.2”.

Section 305.3.2, #3, line 2 delete “in accordance”.

Section 305.4 (Commentary) Clarification that manufactured structures are not “conventional light framed construction and therefore are not eligible for the prescriptive path.

Section 305.4, #1, exception line 2, reference to Span Table is corrected to “Table 305.4.1” Commentary reference also changed to Appendix B 305.4.1.

Section 305.4 #3 Line 6 deleted “s” from “Figure”.

Section 305.4 (Commentary) #3.2 Clarification added regarding the requirements for attachments at 24 inches on center, where the array is located within 3 feet of a hip, edge, ridge, or eave. An illustration was also added.



Section 305.4 (Commentary) #3 Exception #2 line 1, clamp spacing for attachment to standing seam metal roofs. Commentary clarifies the “between or along” spacing requirement.
