VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION

Qualified Counselors provide job readiness assistance to Oregonians who are blind or visually impaired. They work as a team to pair businesses in search of skilled and dedicated employees with a pool of talented job candidates.



YOUTH TRANSITION

Specialized Youth Counselors help ensure that 16 to 21 year old students who are blind or visually impaired successfully transition from high school to college, training or work.



INDEPENDENT LIVING

Skilled Rehabilitation Instructors help Oregon residents 55 years and older who have experienced vision loss stay independent and active. Instructors visit clients in their homes to provide local resources and share strategies for performing everyday tasks such as preparing meals, using the phone, and reading.



BUSINESS ENTERPRISE

Experienced Specialists provide training and ongoing support to qualified Oregonians who are blind and wish to operate food or vending services in Oregon governmental locations.
