We help students throughout Oregon who experience vision loss successfully transition from high school to college/training programs/work. Eligible youth are ages 14-21, legally blind or having a condition leading to legal blindness, and can work legally in the US.

WE OFFER:

- Career exploration: counseling, informational interviews, job shadows, and company tours.
- Work experiences such as after-school internships and work-based assessments/training.
- Counseling toward enrollment in transition and/or post-secondary education.
- Workplace readiness training on social engagement and independent living skills.
- Self-advocacy training and peer mentoring.
- Collaboration with secondary schools, teachers, other community partners, and county disability supports.
- Summer Work Experience Program (SWEP), a specialized summer training program for teens ages 16-20.
