

## **Checklist to Become an Oregon-Approved Supervisor**

Supervision is a statutory requirement for the Clinical Social Work Associate (CSWA). The main goal of supervision is to help the associate learn about the laws and rules that govern social work in Oregon and gain experience in the social work field.

To become an approved supervisor with the board, please complete the following items and email them to: [oregon.blsw@blsw.oregon.gov](mailto:oregon.blsw@blsw.oregon.gov).

### **Must be licensed for at least two years as one of the following:**

- ☐ Licensed Clinical Social Worker in Oregon or another state/jurisdiction
- ☐ Psychiatrist licensed in Oregon
- ☐ Psychologist licensed in Oregon

### **Submit all the following documents:**

- ☐ 15 continuing education hours on topic of: “Techniques of Supervision”
- ☐ Oregon rules and laws exam – signed and dated
- ☐ Copy of current license
