REGARDING: Proposed Rulemaking regarding implementation of HB 2600 – Insurance Coverage while on leave protected by the Oregon Family Leave Act

On October 14, 2015, the Bureau filed with the Oregon Secretary of State a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking regarding proposed adoption of rules to implement house bill 2600, adopted by the Oregon legislature during the 2015 session.
