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**BOLI announces employment law seminars for southern Oregon**

PORTLAND, OR—The Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) will hold a series of employment law seminars in southern Oregon focused on updates to sick time, minimum wage and other workplace rules so that employers can understand and comply with new requirements.

The employment law update seminars will cover both recent and soon-to-take-effect laws, including sick time, minimum wage, ban the box, paycheck transparency, social media privacy and federal overtime changes. In addition, BOLI compliance experts will offer an extensive six-session series for new supervisors starting in early September.
