Registered Apprenticeship (RA) in Oregon is a voluntary system of occupational training in which employers and employees specify the working conditions and related instruction necessary to produce fully qualified journey-level workers for the Industry within a Standards of Apprenticeship document registered with the Bureau of Labor & Industries and approved by the Oregon State Apprenticeship & Training Council (OSATC).

Apprentices actively registered in the Oregon Apprenticeship Tracking System (OATS) must be afforded reasonably continuous employment within the standards of apprenticeship to which they are signatory. This means working and learning for a registered training agent according to the work processes and related instruction as defined in the standards of apprenticeship.

Apprenticeship committees must determine the qualifications, minimum facilities and training conditions required of an employer to serve as an approved training agent and approve training agents accordingly [[ORS 660.137\(5\)\(a\)](#)]. Similarly, apprenticeship committees must withdraw the approval of training agents in violation of the terms of an apprenticeship agreement and associated standards.

While committees may arrange to transfer an apprentice from one training agent to another or to another committee when the committee is unable to provide reasonably continuous employment [Standards boilerplate 11(F)(vii)(a)], the rules, laws, and policies in the state of Oregon do not allow the employer training agent to work registered apprentices outside of the work processes contained within the Standards, Appendix F, unless the apprentice is in a suspended status or is no longer actively registered in OATS.
